What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby Smoothie®: 1 ball each 9313 Loofa

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 13 dc = 4" [10 cm];
5½ rows = 4" [10 cm] in
double crochet. **CHECK YOUR
GAUGE. Use any size hook to
obtain the gauge.**

Textured Blocks Dishcloth

This interesting stitch pattern will keep your hands busy as you crochet a collection of handmade dishcloths for your kitchen.

SHOP KIT

Washcloth measures 7" [18 cm] x 7" [18 cm].

DISHCLOTH

Ch 25.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 24 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each sc across.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, working in back loops only, dc next st, *ch 2, skip 2 sts, working in both loops, dc in next 2 sts; repeat from * to last 2 sts, working in back loops only, dc in last 2 sts.

Row 4: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in next st, *ch 2, skip next 2 dc, working over ch-2 space and into sts in row below, dc in both loops of next 2 sts; repeat from * to last 2 sts, working in back loops only, hdc in last 2 sts.

Repeat Row 4 until piece measures 6½" [16.5 cm] from beginning.

Next Row: Ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, hdc in in next st, *hdc in next 2 sts, working over ch-2 space and into sts in row below, dc in next 2 sts; repeat from * to last 2 sts, working in back loops only, hdc in last 2 sts.

Next Row: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in first 2 sts, sc in each st to last 2 sts, working in back loops only, sc in last 2 sts.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each st across. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

ch = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
