## What you will need:

RED HEART ${ }^{*}$ Scrubby Cotton ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ : 1 ball 7962 Calm Print

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook 5 mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle
GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.

RED HEART ${ }^{\text { }}$ Scrubby Cotton ${ }^{\text {TM }}$, Art. E854 available in solid color $3.5 \mathrm{oz}(100 \mathrm{~g})$ 145 yd ( 133 m ), prints 3 oz $(85 \mathrm{~g}) 121 \mathrm{yd}(110 \mathrm{~m})$ balls


## Corner-to-Corner Crochet Dishcloth

Work your way from one corner to the other while practicing your increase and decrease stitches.

## Scrubby measures 7" [18 cm] x 7"

 [18 cm].
## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Sc3tog: [Draw up a loop in next st] 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook

## NOTES

Scrubby is worked diagonally, increasing sts from one corner to make center 2 corners. Then sts are decreased to make final corner.

## SCRUBBY

Ch 2.
Row 1: 3 sc in 2nd chain from hook - 3 sc Row 2: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first sc, sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc - 5 sc
Rows 3-14: Repeat Row 2 for twelve more times - 29 sc on last row worked.
Row 15: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.
Row 16: Ch 1, turn, skip first sc, sc to last 2 sts, skip next sc, sc in last sc.
Rows 17-28: Repeat Row 16 for twelve more times - 3 sc remain on last row worked.
Row 29: Ch 1, turn, sc3tog. Do not fasten off.

## Edging

Round 1: Ch 1, turn to work along outside edges, hdc evenly around outside edges, working (hdc, ch 2, hdc) in each corner, slip st in first hdc to join. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends

## Abbreviations

$\mathbf{c h}=$ chain; $\mathbf{c m}=$ centimeters; $\mathbf{h d c}=$ half double crochet; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{s c}=$ single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
