## What you will need:

**RED HEART® With Love®:** 1 skein 1207 Cornsilk A

**RED HEART® Pomp-a-Doodle™:** 1 ball 9586 Quirky B

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:** 6.5mm [US K-10½]

Yarn needle, seventeen ⅝" (15.8 mm) wooden beads, tacky glue

**GAUGE:** 13 sc = 4" (10 cm); 13 rows = 4" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**



**RED HEART® With Love®**, Art. E400 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 370 yd (338 m) and multicolor 5 oz (141 g), 230 yd (211 m) skeins



**RED HEART® Pomp-a-Doodle™**, Art. E875 available in 3.5 oz (100 g), 14 yd (13 m) balls

# Crochet Happy Pompom Banner

Simple crochet rows form the top of this banner that is ideal for bedroom décor or setting the scene for party festivities. Add wooden beads to bottom of each strand of pompoms to keep them hanging a bit straighter.

**Banner measures 30" wide x 25" long (76 x 63.5 cm).**

## Note

Cut Pomp-a-Doodle with sharp scissors.

## BANNER Header

With **A**, ch 9.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—8 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 30" (76 cm) long. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## Pompom Strands

Cut 17 strands of **B**, each measuring 28" (71 cm) long, leaving 4" (10 cm) of cord before or after the pompom at each end.

Thread one end of the cord on yarn needle. Insert the needle through a bead and push bead up close to the pompom.



Tie an overhand knot in the yarn close to the bead. Put a dab of glue on the knot and push the bead down over the knot, adhering the knot and bead together. When the glue is dry, trim remaining cord close to the knot.



Referring to photograph as a guide, tie the other end of each bead strand to one edge of header. Tie the strands evenly across, about 2" (5 cm) apart.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B** = Color A, Color B; **ch** = chain(s); **sc** = single crochet.
