

CROCHET BANNER








WHAT YOU'LL NEED



GAUGE

12 **single crochet** (sc) and 15 rows = 4" [10 cm].



YARN

 Red Heart® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

COLORS

Quantity

• **Pumpkin (0254)** 1 ball

Bright Yellow (0324) 1 ballOR

Minty (0520)

1 ball

Note: 1 ball of each color will make approximately (approx) 15 Flags.

TOOLS

- Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.
- Susan Bates® yarn needle.
- Tape measure.

INSTRUCTIONS

USING THIS GUIDE

Click on the underlined words throughout the pattern to access our library of helpful tools.

NOTES

- Banner is made from triangular flags that are strung onto a long <u>chain</u> for hanging.
- Each Flag is worked back and forth in rows from lower tip up to top edge.
- Increases are worked at beginning (beg) and end of every other row to create triangular shape.

SIZE


Each Flag measures approximately (approx) 4" [10 cm] wide x 3½" [9 cm] long.



BANNER Flags

Make as many as desired using yarn colors of your choice.


Make a slip knot and place it on the hook.





Slip knot

Make a loop with yarn and fold it on itself to make a pretzel shape. Then draw through to make slip knot.

INSTRUCTIONS

Chain (ch) 2.

Chain

Yarn over hook (Yoh), draw through loop – 1 chain made.








Repeat (rep) last step once more – 2 chains made.



1st row: 1 single crochet (sc) in second ch from hook. Turn.

Single crochet

Insert hook into second ch from hook under the two top loops (**do not** count loop on hook as a chain); yoh and draw up a loop.



Yoh and draw through both loops on hook – 1 sc made.



INSTRUCTIONS

Increasing *Work 2 sc in indicated stitch.*

2nd row: Ch 1. 3 sc in first sc. Turn.







3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. 3 sc total.



4th row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 5 sc total.



5th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. 5 sc total.

INSTRUCTIONS

6th row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 7 sc total.




7th to 12th rows: Repeat (rep) 5th and 6th rows 3 more times. 13 sc at end of 12th row.



13th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. **Fasten off**.

Fasten off

To permanently fasten off yarn, cut yarn leaving a long tail. Pull the end of yarn through loop on hook and pull gently to tighten.





Repeat all the previous steps to make more triangular flags.

Weave in all yarn tails.

INSTRUCTIONS

Hanging Chain

Make a **slip knot** and place it on the hook. Make ch stitches until hanging chain measures approx 48" [122 cm] or desired length.

Fasten off and weave in yarn tails.



Finishing

Use crochet hook to weave Hanging Chain through spaces between stitches at the top corners of Flags.
