#### What you will need:

RED HEART\* Super Saver\*: 1 skein each of 365 Coffee A, 319 Cherry Red B, and 316 Soft White C

**Note:** Only a small amount of each yarn color is needed.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 3.75 mm [US F-5].

Polyester fiberfill, 18" [45.5 cm] thin gold ribbon (for hanger), stitch marker, yarn needle.

GAUGE: 20 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 20 rows/rounds = 4" [10 cm] in single crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Bottle of Cola Ornament

For those who just can't live without a cola drink, crochet this bottle for their tree! It will certainly bring a refreshing smile to their face.

Ornament measures about 4½" [11 cm] tall.

#### Notes

- Ornament is made from 2 pieces: Bottle and Cap.
- To change yarn color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
- Gauge is not critical for this project.
   Work tightly so stuffing will not show between stitches.

#### **Special Stitch**

sc2tog (single crochet 2 stitches together) = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## **COLA BOTTLE**

With A. ch 2.

Round 1 (right side): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook—6 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed.

**Round 2:** Work 2 sc in each sc around—12 sc.

SC.

**Round 3:** [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—18 sc.

**Round 4:** Working in back loops only, sc in each sc around.

**Round 5:** Sc in each sc around.

Round 6: [Sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog] 3 times—15 sc.

**Rounds 7 and 8:** Sc in each sc around. **Round 9:** [Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times—18 sc.

Rounds 10 and 11: Sc in each sc around and change to **B** in last sc of Round 11. Rounds 12-15: With **B**, sc in each sc around and change to **A** in last sc of Round 15.

Start stuffing bottle and continue to stuff as work progresses.

Round 16: [Sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog] 3 times—15 sc.

Round 17: [Sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog] 3 times—12 sc.

Round 18: Sc in each sc around.

Round 19: [Sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] 3 times—9 sc.

**Round 20:** [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 3 times—6 sc.

**Rounds 21 and 22:** Sc in each sc around. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

### CAP

With B, ch 2.

Round 1 (right side): Work 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first sc—8 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in each sc around; join with slip st in first sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

## **FINISHING**

With **B**, sew Cap to top of Bottle. Label: With yarn needle and **C**, using photograph as a guide, embroider back stitch "Cola" on front of Bottle.

Fold gold ribbon in half. Insert crochet hook around a few stitches at top of ornament, place ribbon fold on hook and draw through to form a loop. Thread ends of ribbon through loop and pull to tighten. Tie ends together with bow or overhand knot to form hanging loop.

Weave in any remaining ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

A, B, and C = Color A, B, and C; ch = chain; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
