## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:**  
1 skein each 334 Buff **A**, 319  
Cherry Red **B**, 313 Aran **C**, and  
385 Royal **D**  
Note Only small quantities of  
each color are needed for this  
project.

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
3.75mm [US F-5]

Yarn needle, stitch marker,  
polyester fiberfill, white  
embroidery floss

**GAUGE:** 4 sc = 1" (2.5 cm); 4  
rounds = 1" (2.5 cm). **CHECK  
YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size  
hook to obtain the gauge.

# Amigurumi Santa Ornaments

Perfect for having your tree be a reflection  
of your love of crochet, this little Santa is  
fun to make and will add to your Christmas  
traditions. Use him throughout your house or  
as a package tie-on.

**4** RED HEART®  
Super Saver®, Art.  
E300 available in  
solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364  
yd (333 m); prints, multis and  
heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yd  
(215 m), flecks 5 oz (141 g),  
260 yds (238 m) skeins

SHOP KIT

Ornament measures 6½" (16.5 cm) tall,  
excluding pompom.

## Notes

1. Head, body, and arms are worked  
in unjoined rounds with right side  
facing at all times. Place marker for  
beginning of round and move marker  
up as each round is completed. Do  
not join until instructed.
2. Hat and beard are worked in turned  
rows.
3. To change color, work last stitch of  
old color to last yarn over. Yarn over  
with new color and draw through all  
loops on hook to complete stitch.  
Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

## Special Stitch

**sc2tog** = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn  
over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over  
and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## ORNAMENT (make 2) Head

Beginning at top, with **A**, ch 2.

**Round 1:** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from  
hook—6 sc. Place marker for beginning  
of round and move marker up as each  
round is completed.

**Round 2:** Work 2 sc in each sc  
around—12 sc.

**Round 3:** \*Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc;  
repeat from \* around—18 sc.

**Round 4:** \*Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next  
sc; repeat from \* around—24 sc.

**Round 5:** Sc in each sc around.

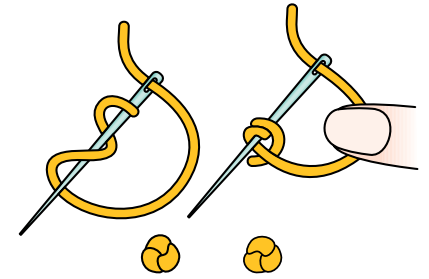
**Round 6:** \*Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next  
sc; repeat from \* around—30 sc.

**Rounds 7-11:** Repeat Round 5.

**Round 12:** \*Sc2tog; repeat from \*  
around—15 sc.

**Round 13:** Repeat Round 5; join with slip  
st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long  
tail.

With **D**, embroider **French knot** eyes on  
Round 10.



## Body

Beginning at bottom, with **B**, ch 2.

**Rounds 1 and 2:** Work same as Rounds 1  
and 2 of head—12 sc.

**Round 3:** \*Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc;  
repeat from \* around—15 sc.

**Rounds 4-8:** Work same as Round 5 of  
head.

**Round 9:** \*Sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog; repeat  
from \* around—12 sc.

**Round 10:** Work same as Round 5 of  
head. Stuff body with fiberfill.

**Round 11:** Work same as Round 12 of  
head; join with slip st in first sc—6 sc.  
Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Weave tail  
through last round and pull closed.

## Arm (make 2)

With **B**, ch 2.

**Round 1:** Work same as Round 1 of  
head—6 sc.

**Round 2:** Repeat Round 3 of head—9 sc.

**Rounds 3-6:** Repeat Round 5 of head;  
join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off,  
leaving a long tail. Do not stuff.

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## Beard

With **C**, ch 2.

**Row 1:** Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn—2 sc.

**Row 2 (right side):** Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc, turn—4 sc.

**Rows 3 and 4:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn—8 sc.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Round 6:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog; \*working in ends of rows, work 6 sc evenly spaced\* down first side; working in opposite side of foundation ch, 3 sc in ch; repeat from \* to \* up other side; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## Waistband

With **C**, ch 18.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## Hat

### Ribbing

With **C**, ch 5.

**Row 1 (right side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—4 sc.

**Rows 2-29:** Ch 1, sc in back loop of each sc across, turn.

**Row 30:** Repeat last row; change to **B**, turn.

## Crown

**Row 1 (right side):** Ch 1, working in ends of rows, sc in each row across, turn—30 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog; repeat from \* across, turn—24 sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog; repeat from \* across, turn—18 sc.

**Row 5:** Repeat Row 3.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, \*sc in next sc, sc2tog; repeat from \* across, turn—12 sc.

**Row 7:** Repeat Row 3.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, \*sc2tog; repeat from \* across, turn—6 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

## Assembly

Arms Weave tail through last round and pull stitches closed, then sew in place at top of body.

Head & Body Stuff head with fiberfill. Push Round 13 of head onto top of body. With end tail, sew securely around to join head to body. Sew waistband around body.

Hat Weave tail through last row and pull closed. Working through ends of rows, sew back seam. Working in ends of ribbing, sew hat on head.

## FINISHING

### Pompom (make 2)

Cut a 15" (38 cm) strand of **C** and set aside. Wrap **C** around 4 fingers 50 times. Carefully slide loops off fingers and tie single strand very tightly around center of loops. Do not cut or trim center tie. Cut loops open at both ends. Shake and trim evenly to desired length. Thread ends of center tie through top of hat and secure pompom.

Cut strand of white embroidery floss to desired length for hanging loop, thread through top of ornament and tie ends in a knot.

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color **A**, Color **B**, Color **C**, etc.;  
**ch** = chain(s); **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
