## What you will need:

### RED HEART Mixology Prints™:

1 ball 969 Moonlit Print **A**

### RED HEART Mixology Swirl™:

1 ball 9969 Moonlit **B**

### RED HEART Mixology Solids™:

1 ball each 10 White **C** and 12 Black **D**

### RED HEART® Super Saver®:

1 skein 341 Light Grey **E**

**Note:** Only a small quantity of **E** is needed for this project.

# Moonlit Crochet Wall Hangings

*Choose your favorite combination of Mixology yarns for a crochet wall hanging. Designed at a beginner level of crochet, so you don't need much experience to create this modern room accent.*

## What you will need continued:

### Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:

9mm [US M-13]

Large eye yarn needle, locking stitch marker,  
¼" diameter x 12" long (6 mm x 30.5 cm)  
dowel or stick and 1 yd (.91 m) twine

**GAUGE:** 6 sts = 4" (10 cm); 4 rows = 4"  
(10 cm) in double crochet. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

**Wall hanging measures 6½" wide and 10" long (16.5 x 25.5 cm).**

## Notes

1. Wall hanging is worked in turned rows.
2. To change color, work the last stitch to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Do not cut any color until instructed.

## WALL HANGING

### Lower Section

With **A**, ch 11.

**Row 1 (right side):** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (beginning ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across, turn—10 hdc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc here and throughout), hdc in each st; change to **B**, turn. Cut **A**.

First Block

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in next 3 sts; leave remaining stitches unworked, turn—4 dc.

**Rows 4 and 5:** Ch 3, dc in each st, turn. Remove hook and place stitch on marker. 2nd Block

**Row 3 (right side):** With right side facing, join **C** with slip st in first unworked st of Row 3 of first side, ch 3, dc in each unworked st, turn—4 dc.

**Rows 4 and 5:** Ch 3, dc in each st, turn. Upper Section

**Row 6 (wrong side):** Ch 3, dc in next 4 sts, insert hook in next st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops, drop **C**, place **B** loop on hook and draw through 2 loops on hook, dc in last 4 sts; change to **A**, turn—10 dc. Cut **B** and **C**.

**Rows 7–9:** Ch 2, hdc in each st, turn.

**Row 10:** Repeat last row; change to **B**. Cut **A**.

**Rows 11 and 12:** Ch 2, hdc in each st, turn. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Refer to photograph as a guide for placement.

### Fringe

Cut 12 strands of **E**, each 8" (20.5 cm) long; separate into 3 groups of 4 strands. Fold strands in half to form a loop. With right side facing, insert crochet hook from front to back and up to front again between first 2 stitches of Row 11. Place fold on hook and draw fold through, forming a loop. Thread ends of strands through loop and pull to tighten. Repeat to attach fringe between 2nd and 3rd stitches and between 3rd and 4th stitches. Trim ends evenly.

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## Hanging Loops

Cut 5 strands of **E**, each 8" (20.5 cm) long. Fold each strand in half and tie ends together with an overhand knot to form a loop. With right side and top edge facing, thread folded end of loop from front to back through first stitch of Row 12, open strands of hanging loop below knot and insert the folded end. Pull up the folded end so knotted end tightens around stitch. Repeat to join remaining 4 hanging loops in top of 3rd, 5th, 7th, and last stitches. Adjust as needed to place knots on wrong side. Weave in ends. Insert dowel or stick through hanging loops and tie on twine for hanging.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.;  
**ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es).
