## What you will need:

### RED HEART Mixology Solids™:

1 ball each 342 Taupe **A** and 530 Plum **C**

### RED HEART Mixology Swirl™:

1 ball 9961 Renaissance **B**

### RED HEART Mixology Prints™:

1 ball 961 Renaissance Print **D**

### RED HEART® Super Saver™:

1 skein 313 Aran **E**

**Note:** Only a small quantity of **E** is needed for this project.

# Renaissance Crochet Wall Hanging

*Choose your favorite combination of Mixology yarns for a crochet wall hanging. Designed at a beginner level of crochet, so you don't need much experience to create this modern room accent.*

What you will need continued:

### Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:

9mm [US M-13]

Large eye yarn needle, ¼" diameter x 12" long (6 mm x 30.5 cm) dowel or stick and 1 yd (.91 m) twine

**GAUGE:** 6 sts = 4" (10 cm); 4 rows = 4" (10 cm) in double crochet. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

**Wall hanging measures 6½" wide and 10" long (16.5 x 25.5 cm).**

### Notes

1. Wall hanging is worked in turned rows.
2. To change color, work the last stitch to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Drop old color to wrong side and proceed with new color. Do not cut any color until instructed.

## WALL HANGING

With **A**, ch 11.

**Row 1 (right side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—10 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in each st, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, dc in next 5 sts; change to **B**, drop **A**; dc in last 4 sts, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, dc in next 4 sts; change to **A**, drop **B**; dc in last 5 sts; change to **C**, turn. Cut **A**.

**Row 5:** Ch 3, dc in next 3 sts; change to **B**, drop **C**; dc in last 6 sts, turn.

**Row 6:** Ch 3, dc in next 6 sts; change to **C**, drop **B**; dc in last 3 sts, turn.

**Row 7:** Ch 3; dc in next st; change to **B**, drop **C**; dc in last 8 sts, turn.

**Row 8:** Ch 3, dc in next 8 sts; change to **C**, drop **B**; dc in top of beginning ch; change to **D**, drop **C**; turn. Cut **B** and **C**.

**Row 9:** Ch 3, dc in each st, turn.

**Row 10:** Repeat Row 9; change to **A**. Cut **D**.

**Row 11:** Ch 2, hdc in each st. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Refer to photograph as a guide for placement.

### Fringe

Cut 12 strands of **E**, each 8" (20.5 cm) long; separate into 3 groups of 4 strands. Fold strands in half to form a loop. With right side facing, insert crochet hook from front to back and up to front again between first 2 **C**-color stitches of Row 2. Place fold on hook and draw fold through, forming a loop. Thread ends of strands through loop and pull to tighten. Repeat to attach fringe between 2nd and 3rd stitches and between 3rd and 4th stitches. Trim ends evenly.

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## Hanging Loops

Cut 5 strands of **E**, each 8" (20.5 cm) long. Fold each strand in half and tie ends together with an overhand knot to form a loop. With right side and top edge facing, thread folded end of loop from front to back through ch-2 space of Row 11, open strands of hanging loop below knot and insert the folded end. Pull up the folded end so knotted end tightens around stitch. Repeat to join remaining 4 hanging loops in top of 4th, 6th, 8th, and last stitches. Adjust as needed to place knots on wrong side. Weave in ends. Insert dowel or stick through hanging loops and tie on twine for hanging.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.;  
**ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet;  
**st(s)** = stitch(es).
