What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\oplus}$ : 1 skein each 316 Soft White A, 312 Black B and 254 Pumpkin C

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 5.5 mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 12 sts $=4 "[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$; 15 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in single crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge. available in solid color 7 0z (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multicolor, heather and print $50 z$ ( 141 g ), 244 yd ( 223 m ), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds ( 238 m ) skeins


## Halloween Party Banner

Enchant your guests with a crocheted party banner in a sophisticated color scheme. It's great for accenting the mantel or anywhere
the spirit moves you.

Finished measurement: 8" high ( 20 cm ) high $x 4$ ' wide ( 1.2 m )

Note: Carry colors not in use loosely along side of work.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

sc2tog: [draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook. sc3tog: [draw up a loop in next st] 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

## CHEVRON FLAG (make 4)

With A, ch 2
Row 1: 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn - 3 sts.
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st, sc in last st, drop A, turn - 3 sts.
Row 3: Join B, ch 1, sc in first st, 3 sc in next st, sc in last st, turn - 5 sts.
Row 4: Ch 1, sc2tog, 3 sc in next st, sc2tog, drop B, turn - 5 sts.
Row 5: Join A, ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in last 2 sts, turn - 7 sts.
Row 6: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next st, 3 sc in next st, sc in next st, sc2tog, drop A, turn - 7 sts.
Row 7: Join B, ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in last 3 sts, turn - 9 sts.
Row 8: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, drop B, turn - 9 sts.

Row 9: Join A, ch 1 , sc in first 4 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in last 4 sts, turn - 11 sts.
Row 10: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog, drop A, turn - 11 sts.

Row 11: Join B, ch 1, sc in first 5 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in last 5 sts, turn - 13 sts.
Row 12: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc here and throughout), sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog, hdc in last st, drop B, turn - 13 sts.

Row 13: Join A, ch 2, hdc in base of ch-2, sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog, 2 hdc in last st, turn 15 sts.
Row 14: Ch 2, hdc in base of ch-2, sc3tog, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, sc3tog, 2 hdc in last st, drop A, turn - 15 sts. Row 15: Join B, ch 2, 2 hdc in base of ch-2, sc3tog, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, sc3tog, 3 hdc in last st, turn 17 sts.
Row 16: Ch 2, hdc in base of ch-2, sc in next st, sc3tog, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, sc3tog, sc in next st, 2 hdc in last st, drop B, turn - 17 sts.
Row 17: Join A, ch 2, 2 hdc in base of ch-2, sc in next st, sc3tog, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, sc3tog, sc in next st, 3 hdc in last st, turn — 19 sts.
Row 18: Ch 2, hdc in base of ch-2, sc in next 2 sts, sc3tog, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, sc3tog, sc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in last st, drop A, turn - 19 sts.
Row 19: Join B, ch 1, sc in first st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, tr in next 3 sts, dc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next st, tr in next 3 sts, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in last st, do not turn - 19 sts.
Edging Round: Ch 1, rotating piece, work sc evenly spaced around, working 3 sc at each corner.
Fasten off.

## SOLID FLAG (make 3)

With C, ch 2.
Row 1: Work 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn - 3 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn 3 sts.
Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn 3 sts.

Continued..

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Row 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, 2 sc in last st, turn - 5 sts.
Row 5: Ch 1 , sc in each st across, turn - 5 sts.
Row 6: Ch 1 , sc in each st across, turn - 5 sts.
Row 7: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st across to last $\mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last st , turn -7 sts .
Row 8: Ch 1 , sc in each st across, turn - 7 sts.
Row 9: Ch 1 , sc in each st across, turn - 7 sts Row 10: Ch 1,2 sc in first st, sc in each st across to last $s t, 2$ sc in last st, turn - 9 sts. Row 11: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn 9 sts.
Row 12: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn 9 sts.
Row 13: Ch 1,2 sc in first st, sc in each st across to last st, 2 sc in last st, turn — 11 sts. Row 14: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn 11 sts.
Row 15: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn 11 sts.
Row 16: Ch 1,2 sc in first st, sc in each st across to last st, 2 sc in last st, turn - 13 sts. Row 17: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn 13 sts.
Row 18: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn 13 sts.
Row 19: Ch 1,2 sc in first st, sc in each st across to last st, 2 sc in last st, turn — 15 sts. Row 20: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn 15 sts.
Row 21: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn 15 sts.
Row 22: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st across to last st, 2 sc in last st, turn — 17 sts . Row 23: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn 17 sts.
Row 24: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn 17 sts.

Row 25: Ch 1,2 sc in first st, sc in each st across to last st, 2 sc in last st, turn - 19 sts. Edging Round: Ch 1, rotating piece, work sc evenly spaced around, working 3 sc at each corner.
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Tie
Row 1: With B, ch 16, *slip st across top of one Chevron Flag, ch 4, slip st across top of one Solid Flag, ch 4; repeat from * until one Chevron Flag remains, slip st across top of last Cheuron Flag, ch 16.
Fasten off.
Weave in ends.

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; ch = chain; cm = centimeters; $\mathbf{d c}=$ double crochet; $\mathbf{h d c}=$ half double crochet; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{s c}=$ single crochet; $\mathrm{st}(\mathrm{s})=$ stitch(es); $\mathbf{t o g}=$ together; $\mathrm{tr}=$ triple or treble crochet; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
