



CROCHET SKILL LEVEL BEGINNER

What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 1 ball each Teal 9518, Tangerine 4422 and Lavender 3720

Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9] 7" (17.8 cm) tall cardboard letters, Craft glue or hot glue gun

GAUGE: Flower measures 2" (5.1 cm) diameter



RED HEART® Soft®, Art. E728 available in solid color 5 oz (141 g),

256 yd (234 m), print 4 oz (113 g), 204 yd (187 m), and heather 4oz (113g), 212 yd (194m) balls



FLOWERS

(Make 2 flowers for each letter)

Ch 4, join with slip stitch to make a ring. **1st petal:** *Sc into ring, ch 7. Repeat from * 6 times – 7 petals. Slip st into first sc. Fasten off and weave in ends.

WRAP THE LETTERS

1. Cut short pieces of yarn and glue to ends of letters.



2. Cover all surfaces of the letter by gluing an area and then wrapping yarn to cover it.



3. Glue your flowers in place as desired or to cover messiest areas.
