## What you will need:

RED HEART® ${ }^{\text {Anne Geddes }}$ Baby ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ : 3 balls 504 Robin A, 1 ball each of 100 Lily B and 203 Daffodil C

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 5 mm [US H-8] and 3.5 mm [US E-4]

Stitch markers, yarn needle
GAUGE: $12 \mathrm{dc}=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$; 6 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in double crochet using 2 strands of yarn held together. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

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RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ Anne Geddes Baby ${ }^{\text {mon }}$, Art. E805 available in solid $3.50 z(100 \mathrm{~g}) 340 \mathrm{yd}(310 \mathrm{~m})$ and multi $3.5 \mathrm{oz}(100 \mathrm{~g}) 290 \mathrm{yd}$ ( 265 m ) balls


## Royal Heir Wall Hanging

Give baby the royal treatment with this clever wall hanging! Crocheted in soft baby colors as shown, or in colors you are using for your own baby decorating theme, this is the perfect way to complete the nursery. If you'd like to personalize your wall hanging, the A to $Z$ alphabet can be found in pattern LW3716.

## Wall Hanging measures 20 " $[50 \mathrm{~cm}$ wide x

 30 " $[76 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] tall.
## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

sc2tog: [lnsert hook in next st, yarn over, draw yarn through st] twice, yarn over, draw yarn through 3 loops on hook.
sc3tog: [Insert hook in next st, yarn over, draw yarn through st] 3 times, yarn over, draw yarn through 4 loops on hook.
Bpdc (back post double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook from back side of work to front and to back again around the post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.
Fpdc (Front post double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.
puff = Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and pull up a loop, [yarn over, insert hook in same st, yarn over and pull up a loop] 3 times, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

## HANGING

With 2 strands of $\mathbf{A}$ held together and larger hook, ch 64.
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across - 63 sc.
Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, dc in next 6 sts, *ch 1, skip next st, dc in next 7 sts; repeat from * across. Rows 3-4: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 6 sts, *ch 1, skip ch-1 space, dc in next 7 sts; repeat from * across.

Row 5: Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1), turn, skip next st, dc next st, *ch 1, skip next st, dc

Rows 6-37: Repeat Rows 2-5.
Rows 38-40: Repeat Rows 2-4.
Row 41: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across - 63 sc.

## Tabs

Row 42: Ch 1, turn, working in front loops only, sc in next 9 sc , leave remaining sts unworked.
*Rows 43-54: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 9 sc.
Joining Row: Fold Tab in half to wrong side to line up with wrong side of Row 41, working through both sts of Row 54 and unworked back loops of Row 41, sc in each st across to join*, sc in next 13 sts of Row 41, repeat from * to * for 2nd tab, [sc in next 14 sts of Row 41, repeat from * to * for next tab] twice, sc in next 13 sts of Row 41, repeat from * to * for last tab.

## FINISHING

## First Point

Row 1: With 2 strands of $B$ held together and larger hook, working across opposite side of foundation ch, join yarn in first ch 1 , sc in same ch, sc in next 62 ch - 63 sc.
Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 12 sc, leave remaining sts unworked.
Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, sc2tog, sc to last 3 sc , sc2tog, sc in last sc -10 sc .
Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.
Rows 5-8: Repeat Rows 3-4-6 sc on last row. Row 9: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, [sc2tog] twice, sc in last sc - 4 sc.
Row 10: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.
Row 11: [Sc2tog] twice - 2 sc.
Row 12: Sc2tog.
Fasten off.

## Yarnspirations"

## Second Point

Row 2: With 2 strands of B held together and arger hook, join yarn in next unworked st on Row 1, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next 11 sc 12 sc.
Work as for First Point.

## Third Point

Row 2: With 2 strands of $\mathbf{B}$ held together, join yarn in next unworked st on Row 1, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next $14 \mathrm{sc}-15 \mathrm{sc}$.
Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, sc2tog, sc to last 3 sc, sc2tog, sc in last sc - 12 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.
Rows 5-12: Repeat Rows 3-4-5 sc on last row.
Row 13: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, sc3tog, sc in last sc - 3 sc.
Row 14: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across
Row 15: Sc3tog.
Fasten off.

## Fourth and Fifth Point

Work as for Second Point.

## Edging

With 2 strands of $\mathbf{B}$ held together and larger hook, join yarn in first row along one side edge, sc evenly spaced around Points, working 3 sc in each point. Fasten off.

## LETTERS

## R

With smaller hook and 1 strand of $\mathbf{B}$, ch 8 .
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 7 sc.

Row 2: Ch 5, turn, skip 3 sc, sc next sc for center sc, ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd ch from hook and next 3 ch , slip st in center sc, sc in 4 ch of first ch-5 space, slip st in edge of Row 1. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## 0

With smaller hook and 1 strand of B ch 17, slip st in first ch to join.
Round 1: Sc in each ch around.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## Y

Make 2
Row 1: With smaller hook and 1 strand of B, [ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch] twice, slip st in first ch, ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch, slip st in same slip st. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## A

Make 2
Row 1: With smaller hook and 1 strand of $\mathbf{B}$, ch 8, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch, ch 3, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next ch for center bar, sc in next 3 ch of ch-8, turn, ch 4, slip st in tip of center bar, ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd ch from hook and next 3 ch , sc in slip st, sc in last 4 ch, slip st in first st.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## L

With smaller hook and 1 strand of B, ch 12
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 2 ch, skip next ch, sc in last 7 ch .
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## B

## Make 2

With smaller hook and 1 strand of B, ch 8 .
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 7 sc.

Row 2: Ch 5, turn, skip 3 sc, sc in next sc, ch 6, skip next 2 sc, slip st in last sc.

Row 3: Turn, skip slip st, sc in next 6 ch, slip st in sc, sc in last 5 ch , slip st in edge of Row 1. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Arrange Letters to spell "Royal Baby" in center of first 2 rows of Squares of Wall Hanging and sew in place.

## PLAQUE

Carry colors not in use loosely alongside of work.
With smaller hook and 1 strand of $\mathbf{B}$, ch 41 .
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 40 sc.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc in each sc across
Rows 3-4: Change to $A$, ch 1 , turn, sc in each st across.
Row 5: Change to B, ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.
Row 6: Ch 3, turn, dc in each sc across Rows 7-42: Repeat Rows 3-6.

## Border Edging

Round 1: Ch 1, turn, sc evenly spaced around all edges, working 3 sc in each corner, slip st in first sc.
Round 2: Ch 1, *sc in each sc to first sc of corner, slip st in first sc, ch 4, slip st in next sc, ch 4 , slip st in same sc, ch 4 , slip st in next sc; repeat from *, sc in each sc to first st, slip st in first st.

## Yarnspirations"

Round 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, working 5 sc in each ch-4 space and slip st each slip st in each corner.
Fasten off.

## CROWN

With smaller hook and 1 strand of $\mathbf{C}$, ch 25 . Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across - 24 sc.
Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.
Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, puff in next sc, *sc in next 3 sc , puff in next sc; repeat from * across to last $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in last 2 sts.
Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.
Row 8: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.
Row 9: Ch 3, turn, *Bpdc, Fpdc; repeat from *
to last st, dc in last st.
Rows 10-11: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

## Shape Points

## Right Point

Row 12: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 7 sc , leave remaining sts unworked - 7 sc.
Row 13: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc - 7 sc.
Row 14: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.
Row 15: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sc 6 sc.
Row 16: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc , sc2tog.
Row 17: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sc 5 sc.
Row 18: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc-6 sc.
Row 19: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sc 5 sc.
Row 20: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 3 sc , sc2tog 4 sc.
Row 21: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc 3 sc.
Row 22: Ch 1, turn, sc in next sc, sc2tog - 2 sc.

Row 23: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog - 1 sc. Fasten off

## Middle Point

Row 12: Join C in next unworked st of Row 11, ch 1 , turn, sc in same st, sc in next 9 sc, leave remaining sts unworked - 10 sc.
Row 13: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.
Row 14: Ch 1 , turn, sc2tog, sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog - 8 sc.
Rows 15-16: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across. Row 17: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each sc to last 2 sc, sc2tog - 6 sc.
Rows 18-20: Repeat Rows 15-17-4 sc.
Row 21-24: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.
Row 25: Ch 1, turn, [sc2tog] twice - 2 sc.
Row 26: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog - 1 sc.
Fasten off

## Left Point

Row 12: Join C in next unworked st of Row 11, ch 1, turn, sc in same st, sc in next 6 sc, leave remaining sts unworked - 7 sc .
Row 13: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog - 7 sc.
Row 14: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.
Row 15: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 5 sc , sc2tog 6 sc.
Row 16: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next sc.
Row 17: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 4 sc , sc2tog 5 sc.
Row 18: Ch 1 , turn, sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc -6 sc.
Row 19: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 4 sc , sc2tog 5 sc.
Row 20: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 3 sc 4 sc.
Row 21: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 2 sc , sc2tog 3 sc .
Row 22: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next sc - 2 sc.
Row 23: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog - 1 sc.
Fasten off

## Edging

With right side facing, join C in any st, sc evenly spaced around edges of Crown, working 3 sc in each point and corners, slip st to first st. Fasten off.

## Large Star

With smaller hook and 1 strand of $\mathbf{C}$, ch 2 .
Round 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook, slip st in first sc .
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around, slip st in first sc - 12 sc.
Round 3: [Ch 4, slip st in 2nd ch from hook, sc next ch, hdc last ch, skip next sc, slip st in next sc] 6 times.
Fasten off.

## Small Star (Make 2)

With smaller hook and 1 strand of C, ch 4, slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), 11 dc in ring, slip st in top of beginning ch -12 dc . Fasten off.

Sew Crown in center of Plaque. Sew Large Star on Middle Point. Sew one Small Star on each remaining Point.

Sew Plaque in center of Wall Hanging. Weave in ends.
