





CROCHET SKILL LEVEL EASY

Designed by Nancy Anderson.

What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each 316 Soft White A, 312 Black B, 672 Spring Green C, 254 Pumpkin D, 358 Lavender E, 885 Delft Blue F, 319 Cherry Red G, 320 Corrmeal H, 334 Buff I, and 365 Coffee J.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 3.75mm [US F-5].

Stitch marker, two 7mm acrylic gems or beads and cement glue for spider eyes, large sharp needle for embroidery, stuffing, plastic pellets or fish tank gravel and knee high hose for weight, yarn needle, small piece (approximately 2" [5 cm] diameter) of cardboard and scissors, black sewing thread and hand sewing needle.

GAUGE: 22 sts = 4" (10 cm); 20 rows = 4" (10 cm) in sc. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

SHOP KIT



Scary Muffins

These scary treats will last from one Halloween to the next! Decorated with embroidered accents, each muffin sits in its own crocheted liner. So easy to make, you'll have a dozen before you know it! Cupcakes measure 6" (15 cm) high.

Special Abbreviations

sc2tog = draw up a loop in next 2 sts, yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

hdc2tog = [yo and draw up a loop in next st] twice, yo and draw through all 5 loops on hook. inc (increase) = 2 sc in next sc.

CUPCAKE LINER

With $\bf A$ (spider) or $\bf C$ (skull) or $\bf B$ (eyeball and pumpkin, ch 13.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across; turn – 12 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in back loop of each sc across changing to E (spider and skull) or **D** (eyeball) or **A** (pumpkin) in last sc; turn.

Rows 3 and 4: Ch 1, sc in back loop of each sc across changing to A or C or B in last sc of Row 4: turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in back loop of each sc across; turn.

Rows 6-34: Repeat Rows 2-5 seven more times, then Row 2 once more. Fasten off **A**, **C** and **B**.

Row 35: Repeat Row 3.

Join Sides-Row 36: Ch 1, working through both layers, sc in back loop of each sc of last row AND remaining loop of beginning ch across: turn.

Liner Bottom-Round 37: Ch 1, working in row ends, 2 sc in first stripe, [2 sc in next stripe, 1 sc in next stripe] 9 times; join with a slip st in first sc - 28 sc.

Round 38: Ch 1, sc in back loops of each sc around; join.

Round 39: Ch 1, [sc in 5 sc, sc2tog] 4 times; join – 24 sc.

Round 40: Ch 1, [sc in 2 sc, sc2tog] 6 times; join – 18 sc.

Round 41: Ch 1, [hdc, hdc2tog] 6 times; join in first hdc - 12 sts. Cut yarn and weave through sts to close hole. Set aside.

CUPCAKE (Spider, Pumpkin, Skull)

With **D** or **A**, ch 2; 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Do NOT join but work in continuous rounds. Place marker in first sc and move up each round.

Round 1: [Inc] 6 times – 12 sc.

Round 2: [Sc in next sc, inc] 6 times – 18 sc.

Round 3: [Sc in next 2 sc, inc] 6 times - 24 sc.

Round 4: [Sc in next 3 sc, inc] 6 times - 30 sc.

Round 5: [Sc in next 4 sc, inc] 6 times - 36 sc.

Round 6: [Sc in next 5 sc, inc] 6 times - 42 sc.

Round 7: [Sc in next 6 sc, inc] 6 times – 48 sc.

Rounds 8-12: Sc in each sc around. Fasten off at end of Round 12.

Round 13: Join **H** or **J** or **I** in back loop of any sc; working in back loops only for this round, sc in each sc around.

Round 14: [Sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog] 6 times – 42 sc.

Rounds 15 and 16: Sc in each sc around.

Round 17: [Sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog] 6 times – 36 sc.

Rounds 18-20: Sc in each sc around.

Round 21: [Sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog] 6 times – 30 sc.

Round 22: Sc in each sc around.

Round 23: Working in back loops only, sc in each sc around.

Round 24: [Sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog] 6 times – 24 sc. Stuff firmly adding pellet packet last. Trace around the bottom of the stuffed cupcake to make cardboard cutout then insert cardboard cutout.

Round 25: [Sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] 6 times – 18 sc.

Round 26: [Hdc in next sc, hdc2tog] 6 times – 12 sts. Cut yarn and weave through sts to close hole. Set aside.

EYEBALL CUPCAKE

With **B**, ch 2; 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with a slip st in first sc.

Continued...



Round 1: [Inc] 6 times; join – 12 sc. Fasten off. Round 2: Join F in back loop of any sc; ch 1, [sc in sc, inc] 6 times; join – 18 sc.

Round 3: Ch 1, [sc in 2 sc, inc] 6 times; join -24 sc.

Round 4: Ch 1, [sc in 3 sc, inc] 6 times; join – 30 sc. Fasten off.

Round 5: Join A in back loop of any sc; ch 1, working in back loops, [sc in 4 sc, inc] 6 times – 36 sc. Do not join but work in continuous rounds. Place marker in first sc and move up each round.

Rounds 6-12: Work same as Cupcake Rounds 6-12.

Rounds 13-26: Join **H** and work same as Cupcake Rounds 13-26.

CUPCAKE DETAIL FINISHING

Simple embroidery is done using 2 plies of yarn and a yarn needle. To prepare yarn for embroidery, cut an 18" (46 cm) length of yarn and carefully pull the yarn apart into 2 separate lengths with 2 plies each.

Eyeball

Bloodshot Eye

Split **G**. With yarn needle, embroider blood vessels in random jagged lines.

Make highlight on pupil with **A**. Insert yarn in pupil and bring needle out about ½" (0.3 cm) from beginning. Fasten off.

Skull

Eye Socket (Make 2)

With B. ch 4.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across; turn – 3 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 2 sc. Fasten off.

Referring to photograph, place eye sockets and attach using matching thread and hand

sewing needle, for best results. Embroider nose and mouth with **B**.

Pumpkin

Eye Cutouts (Make 2)

With B, ch 5.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and next ch, sc2tog over last 2 ch; turn – 3 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next sc, slip st in last sc; turn.

Row 3: Sc in next sc. Fasten off. Set aside. Attach eyes using matching sewing thread and hand sewing needle.

Embroider mouth cutout with **B**. Begin by outlining the mouth using long sts. Fill in what would be the mouth cutout using shorter sts placed side by side.

Spider and Web

With **B**, ch 2; 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not ioin.

Round 1: [Sc in next 2 sc, inc] twice - 8 sc.

Round 2: Sc in each sc around.

Round 3: [Sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] twice – 6 sc. Rounds 4 and 5: Sc in each sc around. Stuff. Fasten off using yarn end to weave through sts and close hole.

Embroider hourglass symbol on back of spider with ${\bf G}$.

Leas

Cut four 10" (25 cm) lengths of **B**. Do not split plies. With one of the lengths, shape the neck by tying the yarn tightly and evenly around the indentation at Round 3. Leave long ends, these will become legs. Insert the remaining 3 lengths of yarn, side by side through the underbelly of the spider, leaving equal amount of yarn on each side. Set aside.

Web

Embroider spider web design with **A**. Begin embroidery by making an asterisk over the

entire frosting portion of the cupcake, using the center of the first 6 sc as the center of the web. Complete the cross webs by making long sts from one horizontal st to the next, following the horizontal lines (from the asterisk) around entire cupcake. Repeat these cross lines for 2 more complete rounds.

Place spider on cupcake in desired location and sew in place using a separate yarn end and just one st (legs will hold spider on cupcake). Thread yarn needle with one of the yarn ends hanging from the spider's underbelly. Insert needle in cupcake about 1½" (4 cm) out from the spider's side. Do not pull tightly; bring needle back out about ¾" (2 cm) from point of insertion and about ½" (0.3 cm) below the line

caused by the yarn. Stitch loop over the leg yarn to create a leg joint. Repeat for remaining legs. Glue 2 red 7mm gem stones on head to form eyes.

All Cupcakes

Weave in ends. Insert finished cupcake into cupcake liner.
