What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ With Love ${ }^{\oplus}$ :
1 skein each 1546 Iris A and 1907 Boysenberry B

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 3.75 mm [US F-5]

Yarn needle, $3 / 4 \mathrm{yd}(.75 \mathrm{~m})$ light beige fabric, sewing needle and matching thread, 18 " ( 45.5 cm ) square pillow form

GAUGE: Rounds 1-3 of Motif \#1 = $4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Circle Motif Pillow

Two colors of yarn and motifs in varying sizes are combined to dress up a purchased pillow and give it elegance, without feeling stuffy. Choose colors that are as bold or as soft as you please to personalize your home style.

## Pillow measures 18 " x 18 " ( $45.5 \times 45.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## Notes

Thirty circular motifs are worked in joined rounds of various sizes with right side facing at all times and sewn to pillow cover.

## PILLOW

## Motif \#1

Size Large (make 2: 1 with each color) Ch 8; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring. Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 15 dc in ring; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-16 dc.
Round 2: Ch 3, dc in same st as join, *ch 2, skip next dc, 2 dc in next dc; repeat from * around, ch 2; join with slip st in top of beginning ch- 16 dc and $8 \mathrm{ch}-2$ spaces. Round 3: Ch 1,2 sc in same st as join, 2 sc in next dc, (ch 1, dc, ch 2, dc, ch 1) in first ch-2 space, *2 sc in next 2 dc , (ch 1, dc, ch 2, dc, ch 1) in next ch-2 space; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc-16 dc, 32 sc, 16 ch-1 spaces, and 8 ch-2 spaces.
Round 4: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, *ch 4, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc, skip next ch-1 space, skip next dc, 5 dc in next ch-2 space, skip next dc, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * 6 times, ch 4, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc; join with slip st in first sc—eight $5-\mathrm{dc}$ groups, 16 sc , and 8 ch-4 spaces. Fasten off.
Size Medium (make 3: 1 with A and 2 with B) Work same as Rounds 1-3 of motif \#1. Fasten off.
Size Small (make 4: 2 with each color)
Work same as Round 1 of motif \#1. Fasten off.

## Motif \#2

Size Extra Large (make 3: 1 with A and 2 with B)
Ch 8; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring. Round 1: Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1), dc in ring, *(ch 1, dc) in ring; repeat from * 5 times, ch 1 ; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-8 dc and 8 ch- 1 spaces.
Round 2: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, *ch 5, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next dc; repeat from * around, ch 5; join with slip st in first sc-8 sc and 8 ch- 5 spaces.
Round 3: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, *ch 8, skip next ch-5 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * around, ch 8; join with slip st in first sc-8 sc and 8 ch-8 spaces.
Round 4: Ch 1, (2 sc, hdc, dc, ch 3, dc, hdc, 2 sc) in each ch-8 space; join with slip st in first sc-8 ch-3 spaces.
Round 5: Slip st in next 3 sts and first ch-3 space, ch 1 , sc in same space, (ch $8, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in each remaining ch-3 space, ch 8; join with slip st in first sc-8 sc and 8 ch- 8 spaces. Fasten off.

## Size Large

With B, work same as Rounds 1-3 of motif \#2. Fasten off.

Size Medium (make 4: 2 with each color)
Work same as Rounds 1 and 2 of motif \#2. Fasten off.

## Size Small

With A, work same as Round 1 of motif \#2. Fasten off.

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## Motif \#3

Size Extra Large (make 3 : 2 with A and 1 with B)
Ch 8; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring Round 1: Ch 1, 16 sc in ring; join with slip st in first sc-16 sc.
Round 2: Ch 1, (sc, dc) in same st as join, ch 2, (dc, sc) in next sc, *(sc, dc) in next sc, ch 2, (dc, sc) in next sc; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc-16 dc, 16 sc , and 8 ch-2 spaces.
Round 3: Slip st in next st and first ch-2 space, ch 3 , dc in same space, (ch 5,2 dc) in each remaining ch-2 space, ch 5; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-16 dc and 8 ch-5 spaces.
Round 4: Ch 3, dc in next dc, *ch 6, dc in next 2 dc; repeat from * around, ch 6; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—16 dc and 8 ch-6 spaces.

Size Large (make 3: 1 with A and 2 with B) Work same as Rounds 1-3 of motif \#3
Fasten off

Size Medium (make 4: 2 with each color) Work same as Rounds 1 and 2 of motif \#3 Fasten off.

## Size Small (make 2 with A)

Work same as Round 1 of motif \#3. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

## Pillow Cover

Cut 2 fabric squares each measuring 19 " x 19 $(48.5 \times 48.5 \mathrm{~cm})$. With right sides together and leaving $1 / 2$ " ( 12.7 mm ) seam allowance, sew around 3 sides and slightly into each end of the 4th side, leaving a large opening for pillow form. Turn right side out and insert pillow form Turning in $1 / 2$ " ( 12.7 mm ) seam allowance, sew 4th side closed

Weave in ends on motifs. Using photograph as a guide for placement, whipstitch motifs to pillow with sewing needle and thread.

$\mathrm{A}, \mathrm{B}=$ Color A, Color $\mathrm{B} ; \mathrm{ch}=$ chain; $\mathrm{dc}=$ double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); ( ) = work directions in parentheses into same st; * $=$ repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
