MATERIALS

Red Heart® **Super Saver**® **O'Go™** (5 oz/141 g; 236 yds/215 m) Main Color (MC) Jeweltone (7195) 3 O'Gos or 593 yds/542 m



Red Heart® Super Saver® O'Go™ (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m) Contrast A White (7100) 1 O'Go or 124 yds/113 m



Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Stuffing. Yarn needle.





CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Bobble Pompom = (Yoh and draw up a loop. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 10 times in 4th ch from hook. Yoh and draw through all 11 loops on hook. Ch 1 tightly to close.

Ch = Chain(s)

Inc = Increase(ing)

Rem = Remain(ing)(s)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

SI st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 17" [43 cm] tall x 20" [51 cm] wide, excluding Bobble Pompom Edging.

GAUGE

14 sc and 17 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- · Pull tie to remove.
- Start crocheting!
- Use O'Go to self-stripe as you go.

FRONT AND BACK HEART (make alike)

Lower Heart

With MC, ch 2.

1st row: (RS). 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 2 sc in next sc. Turn. 4 sc.

3rd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 6 sc.

4th to 26th rows: Rep 3rd row 23 times more, inc 2 sts each row. 52 sts at end of 26th row.

27th row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

28th row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 54 sts.

29th to 44th row: Rep 27th and 28th rows 8 times more, inc 2 sts every other row, ending on a WS row. 70 sts at end of 44th row.

45th to 56th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. Proceed with Right Lobe as follows:

Right Lobe

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 34 sc. Turn leaving rem sts unworked. 34 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. Skip first sc. 1 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 32 sts.

4th and 5th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

6th to 8th rows: Rep 3rd to 5th rows once more. 30 sc at end of 8th row.

9th row: As 3rd row. 28 sts.

10th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

11th to 15th rows: As 3rd row. 18 sts at end of 15th row.

16th row: Ch 1. Skip first sc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 12 sts. Sc2tog. Ch 1. Sl st in last sc. Fasten off.

Left Lobe

With RS facing, skip next 2 unworked sc of 56th row of Lower Heart. Join MC with sl st to next sc. **1st row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. 34 sc.

Beg with 2nd row, work as for Right Lobe across left side of Lower Heart.

Trim

1st rnd: (RS). Join MC with sl st to bottom tip of Lower Heart. Work sc evenly around Heart, making sure total number of sc is a stitch multiple of 4. Join with sl st to first sc. **2nd rnd:** Ch 1. *Working in back loops only,* 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc.

3rd to 5th rnds: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Joining Front and Back: 1st rnd: (RS). With WS of Front and Back facing each other, join A with sl st to any edge st of Pillow. Ch 1. Working through both thicknesses, sc in each sc around, leaving approx 4" [10 cm] hole for stuffing. Stuff Pillow. Complete rnd of sc. Join with sl st to first sc. **Do not** fasten off.

Proceed with Bobble Pompom Edging as follows:

Note: Bobble Pompom Edging worked over st multiple of 4 sts.

1st rnd: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Ch 4. (Yoh and draw up a loop. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 10 times all in 4th ch from hook. Yoh and draw through all 11 loops on hook. Ch 1 tightly to close - Bobble Pompom made. SI st in same 4th ch from hook (Bobble Pompom will naturally fold in half forming a ball shape). 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. *1 sc in next sc. Ch 4. Bobble Pompom in 4th ch from hook. SI st in same 4th ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.
