

## MATERIALS

Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\circledR}$ Stripes ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $5 \mathrm{oz} / 141 \mathrm{~g} ; 236 \mathrm{yds} / 215 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Retro Stripes (4971) $\mathbf{3}$ balls or $\mathbf{6 3 5}$ yds/580 m
Red Heart ${ }^{\circledR}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\circledR}$ ( $7 \mathrm{oz} / 198 \mathrm{~g} ; 364 \mathrm{yds} / 333 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast B Soft White (0316)
Contrast C Black (0312)
1 ball or $117 \mathrm{yds} / 107 \mathrm{~m}$
1 ball or $33 \mathrm{yds} / 30 \mathrm{~m}$
Size U.S. H/8 ( 5 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\circledR}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ stitch marker. Round pillow form 20" [ 51 cm ] diameter. 1 pair of nylon pantyhose/stockings for stuffing casings (this holds stuffing in place and makes sure stuffing does not show through crochet fabric). Polyester fiberfill stuffing. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle. Piece of cardboard, approx $5^{\prime \prime} \times 7$ " [12.5 x 18 cm ] for shoe sole inserts.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 20 " $[51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] diameter. Arms and Legs measure approx 15" [ 38 cm ] long.

## GAUGE

12 sc and 15 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

PILLOW FRONT AND BACK (Make 2 alike) See diagram on page 4.

Rnd(s) $=$ Round(s)
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.
Scbl = Single crochet in back
loop
Sl st = Slip stitch
$\mathbf{S t}(\mathbf{s})=$ Stitch $(\mathrm{es})$
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook
Note: Front and Back are worked in continuous rnds. Do not join at end of rnds. Simply work directly into next stitch, noting marker to indicate end of rnd will move up each rnd.

With A, ch 4.
1st rnd: 10 dc in 4 th ch from hook. Place marker on first dc. Do not join.
2nd rnd: 2 dc in each dc around. 20 dc .
3rd rnd: *2 dc in first dc. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * around. 30 dc .

4th rnd: *2 dc in first dc. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. Rep from * around. 40 dc .
5th rnd: *2 dc in first dc. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc . Rep from * around. 50 dc
6th rnd: *2 dc in first dc. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc . Rep from * around. 60 dc .
Cont as established, inc 10 dc every rnd for 10 more rnds. 160 dc . (Piece should measure approx 20" [ 51 cm ] diameter when slightly stretched).
SI st in first dc at end of last rnd. Fasten off.

## MAKE LEG AND ARM CASINGS

Stuff legs of pantyhose/stockings lightly to create 4 'casings' approx 7" [18 cm] circumference x 15" [ 38 cm ] long. Cut pantyhose/ stockings and tie tightly at ends to close. You should be able to make 2 casings out of each pantyhose/ stocking leg.

LEGS (Make 2 alike)
Note: Legs are worked from bottom up.

Beg at Sole of Shoe:
See diagram on page 5 .
**With B, ch 9 .
1st rnd: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 5 ch .3 hdc in last ch. Do not turn. Working in rem loops of foundation ch, 1 hdc in each of next 5 ch .2 hdc in last ch (same ch as first hdc). Join with sl st to first hdc. 16 hdc.
2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 hdc in first hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 5 hdc .2 hdc in each of next 3 hdc .1 hdc in each of next 5 hdc . 2 hdc in each of last 2 hdc. Join with sl st to first hdc. 22 hdc.
3rd rnd: Ch 1.1 hdc in first hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 5 hdc . ( 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in next hdc) 3 times. 1 hdc in each of next 6 hdc . 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in next hdc. 2 hdc in last hdc. Join with sl st to first hdc. 28 hdc.
4th rnd: Ch 1.2 hdc in first hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 9 hdc . (2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 hdc) 3 times. 1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc. ( 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 hdc ) twice. Join with sl st to first hdc. 34 hdc .**

Sides: 1 st rnd: Ch 1.1 scbl in each hdc around. Join C with sl st to first sc.
2nd rnd: With C, ch 1. Working in both loops, 1 sc in each sc around. Join B with sl st to first sc.

## 3rd rnd: With B, as 2nd rnd.

Fasten off.

Toe: Join B with sl st to 11th sc of last rnd. Ch 10 . Skip next 12 sc . Join with sl st in next sc. SI st in last sc skipped (sc just before sl st join). Turn.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in each ch of ch-10. SI st in each of first 2 skipped sc of 11th rnd. Turn. 10 sc .
2nd row: Sc2tog over first 2 sc of Toe. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc . Sc2tog. Sl st in each of last 2 skipped sc of 11th rnd. Turn. 8 sts. 3rd row: Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc . Sc2tog. SI st in each of next 2 skipped sc of 11th rnd. Turn. 6 sts.
4th row: Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Sc2tog. SI st in each of last 2 skipped sc of 11th rnd. 4 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Using tail end, sew last row of Toe to rem unworked sc of Side to close Toe.

Shoe: Join C with sl st to first sc of 3rd rnd of Side.
1 st rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 10 sc . Working in rem loop of Toe ch-10, 1 sc in each of next 10 ch . 1 sc in each of last 10 sc of 3 rd rnd of Side. Join with sl st to first sc. 30 sc.
2nd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 9 sc . Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc . Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join with sl st to first sc. 28 sts.
3rd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 9 sc. (Sc2tog) 5 times. 1 sc in each of last 9 sc . Join with sl st to first sc. 23 sts.
4th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each st around. Join with sl st to first sc.
5th to 7th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join B with sl st to first sc at end of 7th rnd.

Sock: 8th rnd: With B, ch 1.1 hdc in each sc around.
9th rnd: Ch 1.1 hdc in each hdc around. Fasten off.

## Side Emblem

With B, ch 3.10 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. Join with sl st to first hdc. Pull tail to close ch and fasten securely. Fasten off.
Sew Emblem to outside of Shoe as shown, being sure to make both a Left and a Right Shoe.

## Shoelaces

With B, ch 70. Fasten off.
'Lace' through holes of sc at front of Shoe and tie in bow as shown.

Trace Sole of Shoe onto piece of cardboard and place into Shoe to add structure and keep sole flat. Stuff Shoe.

## LEG

See diagram on page 5.
1st rnd: Join A with sl st to first hdc at top of Sock. Ch 1. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of rnd. PM on first st. Do not join. 22 sts.
2nd rnd: 1 hdc in each st around. Rep last rnd, working in a continuous spiral, until Leg measures approx 5 " [ 12.5 cm ].

Insert Leg casing, and continue to work in continuous spiral around casing, until Leg measures approx 15 " 38 cm ] from bottom of Shoe. Fasten off leaving a long tail at end of last row.
**You may wait to insert casing if preferred, but it becomes increasingly difficult to get it into the Arm/Leg easily as the piece gets longer. (If casing needs more or less stuffing, make appropriate adjustments now).
Fold top of Leg flat, with Shoe facing forward. Sew top of Leg closed with tail along last rnd.

HANDS (Make 2)
See diagram on page 6.
Fingers (Make 4)
With B, ch 3.
1st rnd: 10 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. PM on first hdc. Do not join. Work in continuous rnds. 10 hdc .
2nd rnd: 1 hdc in each hdc around. Working in continuous rnds, 1 hdc in each hdc around for a further 5 rnds. 7 rnds total. SI st in first hdc and fasten off at end of 7th rnd for 3 Fingers, leaving a tail approx 4" [10 cm] long. Do not fasten off at end of 4 th Finger.

Join Fingers: 1st rnd: Work 1 hdc in first hdc. PM in first hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 4 hdc of first finger. Work 1 hdc each of first 5 hdc of second finger. Work 1 hdc in each of first 5 hdc of third finger. Work 1 hdc in all of 10 hdc of fourth finger. Working in rem hdc of each finger, work 1 hdc in each hdc to end of rnd. 40 hdc. Do not join. Work in continuous rnds.
2nd and 3rd rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around.
4th rnd: *Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each of next 8 hdc. Rep from * around. 36 sts.
5th rnd: 1 hdc in each st around.
6th rnd: *Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each of next 4 hdc. Rep from * around. 30 sts.
7th rnd: As 5th rnd.
8th rnd: *Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc. Rep from * around. 24 sts.
9th to 11th rnds: As 5th rnd. Break $B$, join $A$ at end of 11 th rnd.

Stuff Fingers very lightly using lengths of B as stuffing.

## ARM

With A, work in continuous rnds, 1 hdc in each hdc around until Arm measures approx 5 " $[12.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].
Insert Arm casing (adding stuffing around casing to fill-out Hand) and continue to work in a continuous spiral around casing, until Arm measures approx 15 " [ 38 cm ]. Fasten off at end of last rnd leaving a long tail for seaming.
(If casing needs more or less stuffing, make appropriate adjustments now).
Fold top of Arm flat, with Hand facing forward. Sew top of Arm closed with tail along last rnd.

EYES (Make 2)
See diagrams on page 7 .
Work from ** to ** as given for Shoe Sole.
Fasten off at end of last rnd leaving a long tail for seaming.

## Pupil

With C, ch 7.
1st rnd: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 3 ch .3 hdc in last ch. Working in rem loop of foundation ch, 1 hdc in each of next 3 ch .2 hdc in last ch. Join with sl st to first hdc.

## '̌arnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 hdc in first hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc. 2 hdc in each of next 3 hdc .1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc .2 hdc in each of last 2 hdc. Join with sl st to first hdc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.
Using tail, sew Pupil to Eye at center bottom.

## SMILE

See diagram on page 7.
With C, ch 15.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 3 ch . (Sc2tog) 3 times. 1 sc in each of last 4 ch . Fasten off leaving a long tail.

## FINISHING

Pin Eyes and Smile into place on Front. Sew into position using long tails from fasten off.

## Join Front and Back

With WS tog, join A with sl st to any dc of last rnd.
1st rnd: Ch 1. Working through both thicknesses to join, work 1 sc in each dc around, stopping midway to insert pillow form and then completing rnd. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Sew Arms and Legs to Sides and Bottom.
On Right Hand, fold first and last fingers towards center and secure by sewing through both fingers and attaching to palm to create a peace sign.
