Sizes U.S. G/6 (4 mm) and U.S. H/8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hooks **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® stitch markers. Susan Bates® yarn needle. 3 Tissue Boxes, 9" x 4.75 x 4.5" [23 x 12 x 11.5 cm]. Polyfil Stuffing. Pins. Safety Eyes 5/8" [15 mm].

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 10" x 5" x 12" [25.5 x 12.5 x 30.5 cm], excluding hat.

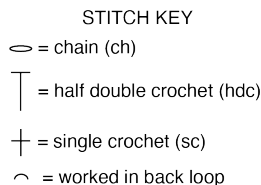
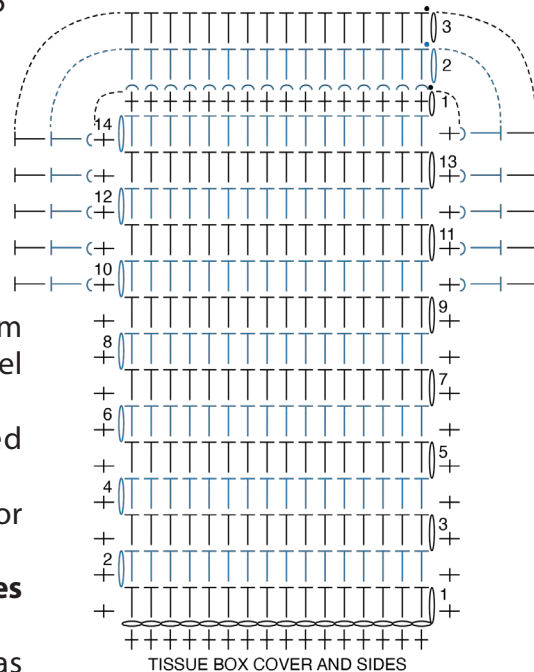
GAUGE

14 hdc and 12 rows =
4" [10 cm] with larger hook.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Tissue Box Cover is worked from top down, beg with top panel and Hat brim.
- The rem of Hat is worked separately and attached later.
- Try the Cover on tissue box for size as you work.
- Ch 1 or ch 2 at beg of rnds **does not** count as st.
- Join with sl st to first sc or as specified otherwise.



TISSUE BOX COVER

Top Panel

With larger hook and A, ch 17.

1st row: 1 hdc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 16 hdc.

2nd to 14th rows: Ch 1. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Sides

Begin working in rnds as follows:

15th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each hdc to end of row. Work 14 sc evenly along first side of Panel. Working in rem loops of foundation ch, 1 sc in each of next 16 ch. Work 14 sc evenly along other side of Panel. Join. 60 sc.

16th rnd: Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 hdc in each sc around. Join. 60 hdc.

17th and 18th rnds: Ch 1. *Working in both loops*, 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join. Fasten off at end of last rnd.

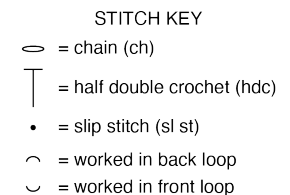
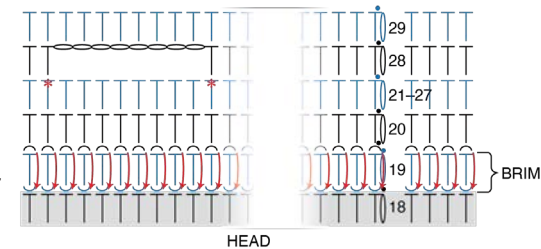
Hat Brim: 19th rnd: With I and K held tog, join with sl st in front loop of first hdc. Ch 2. *Working in front loops only*, 1 dc in each st around. Join. Fasten off. 60 dc.

Head

20th rnd: Join [B for Santa and Elf or E for Reindeer] with sl st to rem back loop of 18th rnd join. Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 hdc in each st around. Join. 60 hdc.

21st to 27th rnds: Ch 1. *Working in both loops*, 1 hdc in each st around. Join.

Your cover should be half way down the length of your tissue box. This is where the tissues will poke out from under the nose at the front of the Cover. If not, add or remove rows as needed. Put cover on box and decide which side will be the front. PM for 8 center hdc of front for tissue slot.

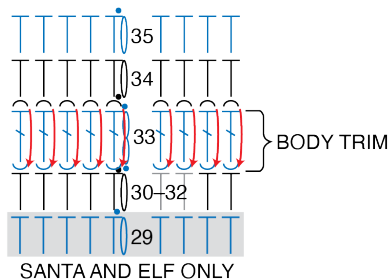


Tissue Slot: 28th rnd: Ch 1. 1 hdc in each hdc to first marker. Ch 8. Skip next 8 hdc. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of rnd. Join. 52 hdc and 1 ch-8 sp.

29th rnd: Ch 1. 1 hdc in each st and ch around. Join. 60 hdc.

Bottom

Santa and Elf Only: 30th to 32nd rnds: Ch 1. 1 hdc in each st around. Join. Fasten off at end of 32nd rnd.



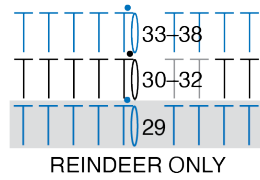

Body Trim: 33rd rnd: With I and K held tog, join with sl st in front loop of first hdc. Ch 2. *Working in front loops only*, 1 dc in each st around. Join. Fasten off. 60 dc.

34th rnd: Join [A for Santa or C for Elf] with sl st to rem back loop of 32nd rnd join. Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join. 60 hdc.

35th rnd: Ch 1. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join. Rep last rnd until Cover reaches end of tissue box. Fasten off.

Reindeer Only: 30th to 32nd rnds: Ch 1. 1 hdc in each st around. Join. Fasten off at end of 32nd rnd.

Collar

33rd rnd: With I and K held tog, join with sl st to first hdc. Ch 1. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join. Fasten off.

34th to 36th rnds: Join C with sl st in first hdc. Ch 1. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join. Fasten off at end of 36th rnd.

37th rnd: With I and K held tog, join with sl st to first hdc. Ch 1. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join. Fasten off.

38th rnd: Join E with sl st in first hdc. Ch 1. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join. Rep last rnd until Cover reaches end of tissue box. Fasten off.

CANDY DISH/POT OF GOLD

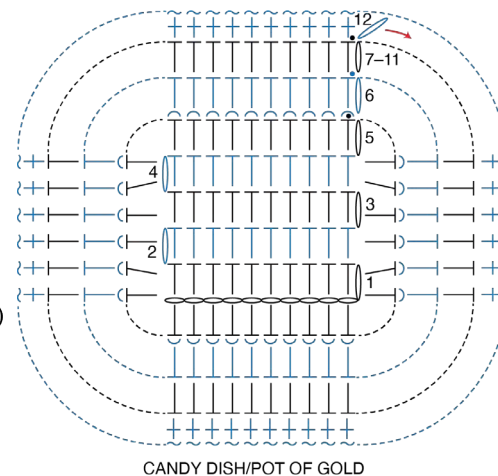
Base

With larger hook and G, ch 11.

1st row: 1 hdc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 10 hdc.

2nd to 4th rows: Ch 1. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Note: When working in continuous rnds, move marker up as you complete each rnd.



Sides

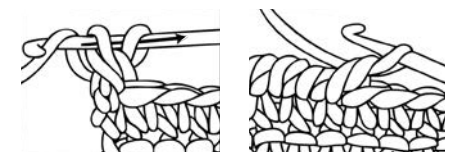
Begin working in continuous rnds.

5th rnd: Ch 1. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. **Do not** turn. *Working along side edge of Base, 2 hdc in end of first row. 1 hdc in end of each of next 2 rows. 2 hdc in end of last row.* Working across rem loops of foundation ch, 1 hdc in each of next 10 ch. Rep from * to * once more. **Do not** join. PM for beg of rnd. 32 sts.

6th rnd: *Working in back loops only*, 1 hdc in each hdc around.

7th to 11th rnds: *Working in both loops*, 1 hdc in each hdc around.

12th rnd: Working from **left to right**, instead of from **right to left**, as usual, work 1 reverse sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

HAT

Santa or Reindeer Only: With larger hook and A, ch 2. Work in continuous rnds.

1st rnd: 6 hdc in 2nd ch from hook. 6 hdc . PM for beg of rnd.

2nd rnd: 2 hdc in each hdc around. 12 hdc.

3rd rnd: 1 hdc in each hdc around.

4th rnd: *1 hdc in next hdc . 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. 18 hdc.

5th and 6th rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around.

7th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 2 hdc . 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. 24 hdc.

8th and 9th rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around.

10th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. 30 hdc.

11th and 12th rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around.

13th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 4 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc . Rep from * around. 36 hdc.

14th and 15th rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around.

16th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 5 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. 42 hdc.

17th and 18th rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around.

19th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 6 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. 48 hdc.

20th and 21st rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around.

22nd rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 7 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. 54 hdc.

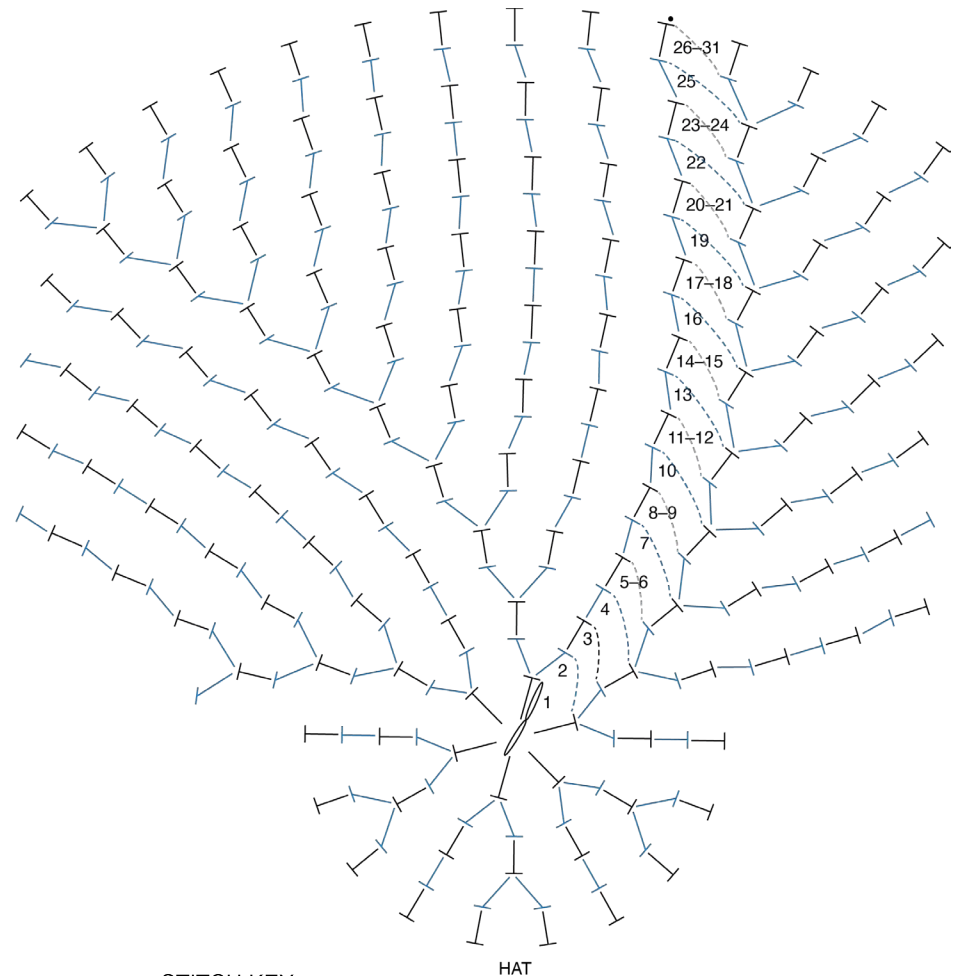
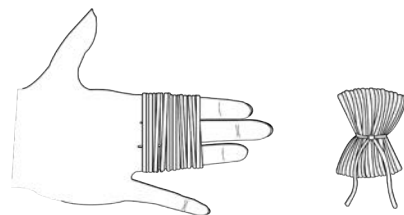
23rd and 24th rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around.

25th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 8 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. 60 hdc.

26th to 31st rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around.

32nd rnd: 1 sc in each of next 2 hdc. Sl st in next hdc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Pompom: Wind I and K around 3 fingers approx 50 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to smooth round shape. Attach Pompom to point of Hat.



STITCH KEY

- = chain (ch)
- ┆ = half double crochet (hdc)

Notes:

- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.
- Carry yarn on WS up side of work when not in use.

Stripe Pat

With A, work 3 rnds.

With C, work 3 rnds.

These 6 rnds form Stripe Pat.

Elf Only: With larger hook and C, ch 2.

1st rnd: 6 hdc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 6 hdc.

2nd rnd: 2 hdc in each hdc around. Join. 12 hdc.

3rd rnd: 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join.

4th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 18 hdc.

5th and 6th rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join with A at end of last rnd. **Do not** break C.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows:

7th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 2 hdc. 2 hdc in hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 24 hdc.

8th and 9th rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join.

10th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 30 hdc.

11th and 12th rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join.

13th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 4 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 36 sts.

14th and 15th rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join.

16th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 5 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Join. Rep from * around. 42 hdc.

17th and 18th rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join.

19th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 6 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 48 hdc.

20th and 21st rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join.

22nd rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 7 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 54 hdc.

23rd and 24th rnds: 1 hdc in each hdcst around. Join.

25th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 8 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 60 hdc.

26th to 31st rnds: 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join. 60 hdc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Pompom: Make same as for Santa and Reindeer.

FACIAL FEATURES

Before you begin, we encourage you to share your personality with these three characters - changing eye colors and more. Be creative and have fun!

Safety eyes can be used in place of the black pupils if preferred.

Irises can be customized to match family members or friends who the Cover is for.

You can also get quite creative with the elf's hair strands! You can make them longer, or wavy or curly! Every elf is unique!

You can make arms longer if you wish.

NOSE

Santa or Elf Only: With smaller hook and B, beg using magic loop method, demonstrated here: <https://www.yarnspirations.com/ca-en/video-y-crochet-magic-loop.html> Work in continuous rnds.

1st rnd: 6 sc in ring. 6 sc. PM for beg of rnd.

2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 12 sc.

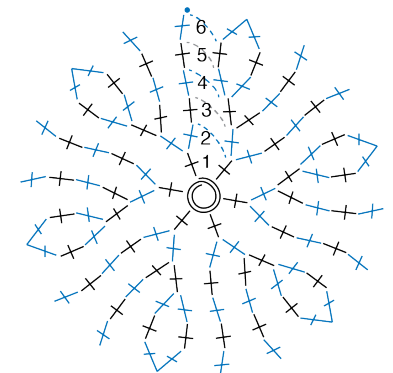
3rd rnd: *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 18 sc.

4th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 24 sc.

5th to 9th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

10th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. 18 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Proceed to Back Plate.

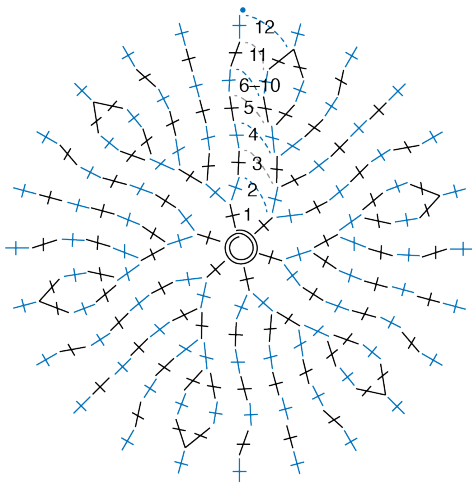

REINDEER'S NOSE

STITCH KEY

- ⊙ = magic ring
- + = single crochet (sc)
- = slip stitch (sl st)

Work in continuous rnds.

1st rnd: 6 sc in ring. 6 sc. PM on last st.

2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 12 sc.

3rd rnd: *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 18 sc.

4th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 24 sc.

5th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 30 sc.

6th to 10th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around. 30 sc.

11th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. 24 sc.

12th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. 18 sc.

13th rnd: 1 sc in each sc around. Join. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Proceed to Back Plate.

Back Plate

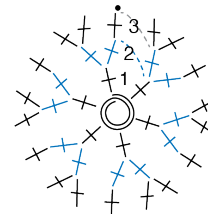
With smaller hook and matching color yarn, beg using magic loop method.

Work in continuous rnds.

1st rnd: 6 sc in ring. 6 sc. PM for beg of rnd.

2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 12 sc.

3rd rnd: *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 18 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



REINDEER NOSE
BACK PLATE

STITCH KEY

- ⊙ = magic ring
- + = single crochet (sc)
- = slip stitch (sl st)

EYES

Whites (make 2)

With smaller hook and I, beg using magic loop method.

Work in continuous rnds.

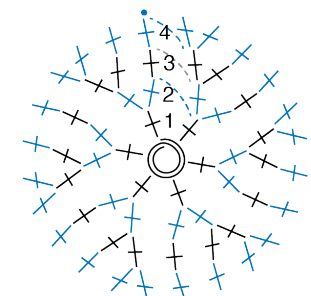
1st rnd: 6 sc in ring. 6 sc. PM for beg of rnd.

2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 12 sc.

3rd rnd: *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 18 sc.

4th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 24 sc. Join.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



EYE WHITE

STITCH KEY

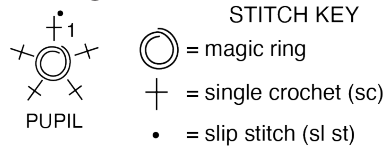
- ⊙ = magic ring
- + = single crochet (sc)
- = slip stitch (sl st)

Pupils (make 2)

With smaller hook and H, beg using magic loop method.

1st rnd: 5 sc in ring. Join.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



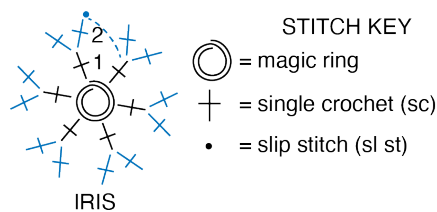
Iris (make 2)

With smaller hook and [E for Santa or F for Elf and Reindeer], beg using magic loop method.

Work in continuous rnds.

1st rnd: 6 sc in ring. 6 sc. PM on last st.

2nd rnd: 2 sc in each st around. 12 sc. Join. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



EARS

Elf Only (make 4): With smaller hook and B, beg using magic loop method. Work in continuous rnds.

1st rnd: 8 sc in ring. 8 sc. PM for. Beg of rnd.

2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 16 sc.

3rd rnd: *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 24 sc.

4th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 32 sc.

5th rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.

Begin working in rows.

6th row: 1 sc in each of next 8 sc. Turn. 8 sc.

7th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 6 sts.

8th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 6 sts. Turn.

9th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 4 sts.

10th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 4 sts. Turn. 4 sc.

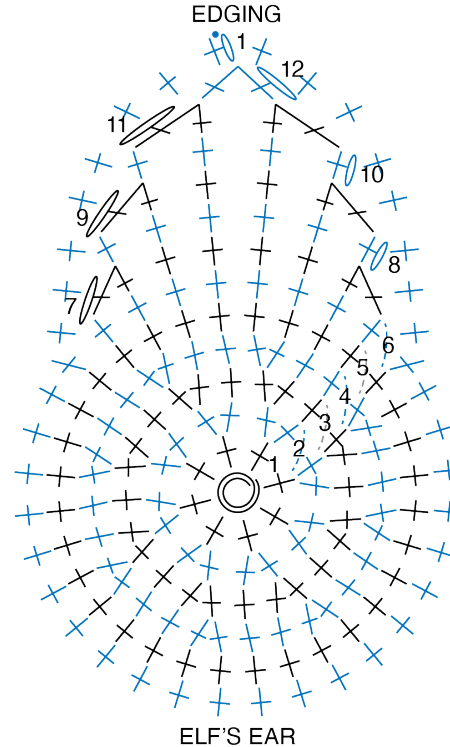
11th row: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. Turn. 2 sts.

12th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. DO NOT turn. 1 st.

Edging rnd: (RS). Work 40 sc evenly around edge of Ear. Join.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Note: Be sure that each of 4 ear pieces have the same number of sts around, as they will be sewn tog later.

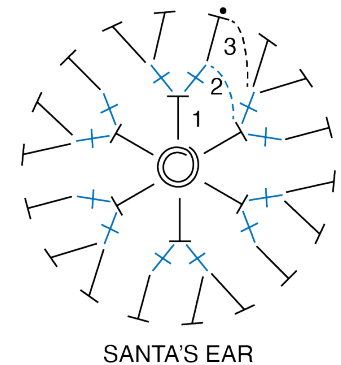


Santa Only (make 2): With smaller hook and B, beg using magic loop method.

1st row: 6 hdc in ring. Turn. 6 hdc.

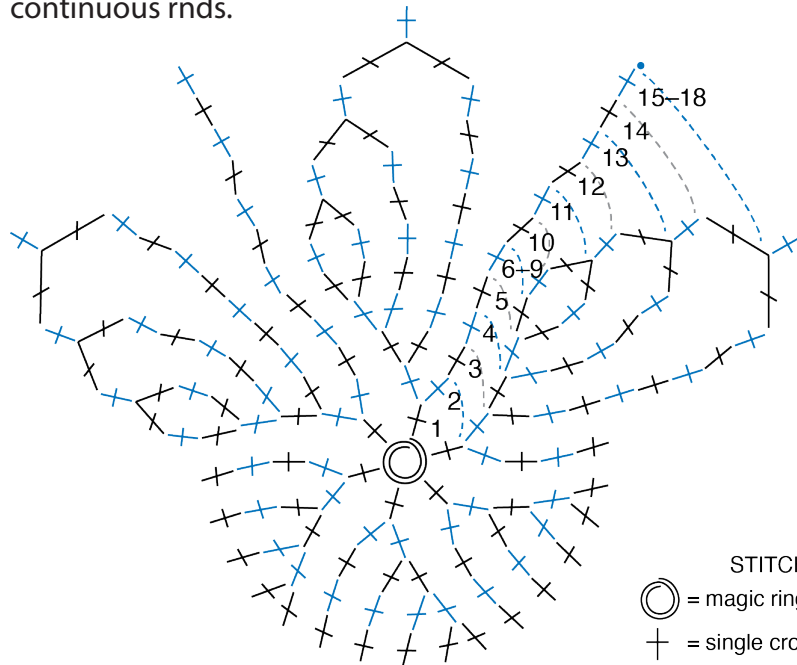
2nd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in each hdc to end of row. Turn. 12 sc.

3rd row: Ch 1. *1 hdc in next hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * to end of row. 18 hdc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



Reindeer Only (make 2): With smaller hook and E, beg using magic loop method. Work in continuous rnds.

5th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 30 sc.



REINDEER'S EAR

1st rnd: 6 sc in ring. 6 sc. PM for beg of rnd.

2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 12 sc.

3rd rnd: *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 18 sc.

4th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 24 sc.

6th to 9th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

10th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 3 sts. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. 24 sts.

11th rnd: 1 sc in each st around.

12th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. 18 sts.

13th rnd: 1 sc in each st around.

14th rnd: *1 sc in next sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. 12 sts.

15th to 18th rnds: 1 sc in each st around. Join. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

HAIR

Santa Only: With larger hook and I, ch 46.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 45 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Cluster in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 45 sts - 23 sc and 22 clusters.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row.

This length should fit across 3 sides of cover behind the face.

4th to 13th rows: Rep 2nd and 3rd rows 5 times more. Fasten off, leaving a 36" [91.5 cm] long tail for sewing.

Elf Only: With larger hook and L, ch 45 loosely. This should fit across 3 sides of Cover behind the face.

1st row: Sl st in 2nd ch from hook.

****Short Hair Strand:** *Ch 10. Sl st in 2nd ch from hook. Sl st in each of next 9 ch. Sl st in next foundation ch. Rep from * 13 times. 14 Short Hair Strands.**

Long Hair Strand: *Ch 14. Sl st in 2nd ch from hook. Sl st in each of next 13 ch. Sl st in next foundation ch. Rep from * 15 times. 16 Long Hair Strands.

Rep from ** to **, working last sl st in the same last ch. Fasten off, leaving a 36" [91.5 cm] long tail for sewing.



MITTENS AND ARMS (Make 2)

With smaller hook and [H for Santa or C for Reindeer or D for Elf], beg using magic loop method.

Work in continuous rnds.

1st rnd: 6 sc in ring. 6 sc. PM for beg of rnd.

2nd rnd: 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in each of next 2 sc. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. 10 sc.

3rd rnd: 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in each of next 2 sts. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 14 sc.

4th rnd: 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 5 sts. 2 sc in each of next 2 sts. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 18 sc.

5th rnd: 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. 2 sc in each of next 2 sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sts. 2 sc in next sc. 22 sc.

6th to 9th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

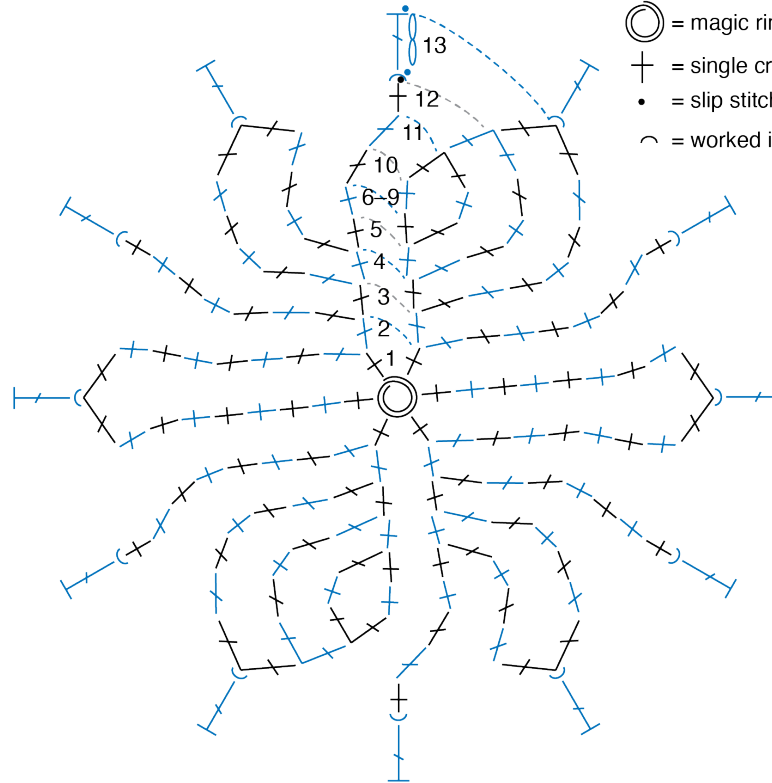
10th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 9 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. 20 sts.

11th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 8 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. 18 sts.

12th rnd: *1 sc in next sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. 12 sts. Join. Fasten off.

With I and K held tog, join with sl st to front loop of last sl st.

13th rnd: Ch 2. Working in front loops only, 1 dc in each st around. Join. Fasten off. 12 dc.



MITTENS AND ARMS
1st-13th ROUNDS

STITCH KEY

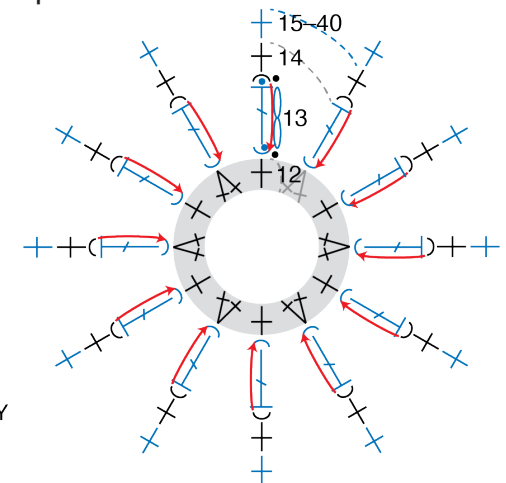
- = chain (ch)
- ⌋ = double crochet (dc)
- ⊙ = magic ring
- + = single crochet (sc)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- ⤴ = worked in back loop

Santa Only: Join A with sl st to back loop of sl st join of 12th rnd.

14th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join. 12 sc. PM for beg of rnd.

Stuff mitten lightly and continue to stuff arm as you go. Work in continuous rnds.

15th to 40th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around. PM for beg of rnd. Join after 40th rnd. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew seam at top of arms.



SANTA'S MITTEN AND ARM
14th-40th ROUNDS

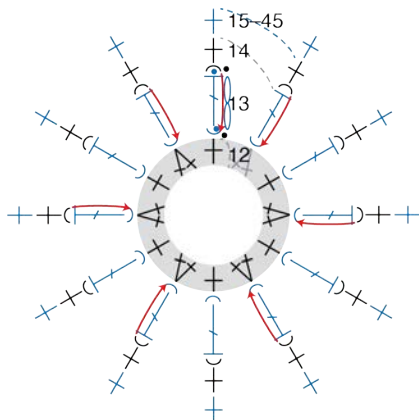
Elf Only: Join A with sl st to back loop of sl st join of 12th rnd.

With A – 4 rnds.

With C – 4 rnds.

These 8 rnds form Stripe Pat.

STITCH KEY

- = chain (ch)
- ⌋ = double crochet (dc)
- ⊕ = single crochet (sc)
- ⋈ = single crochet 2 together (sc2tog)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- ⤴ = worked in back loop
- ⤵ = worked in front loop

14th rnd: With A, ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc around. Join. 12 sc.

First rnd of Stripe Pat complete.

Stuff mitten lightly and continue to stuff arm as you go.

15th to 45th rnds: Cont in Stripe Pat, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join. Fasten off at end of last rnd, leaving a long tail for sewing.

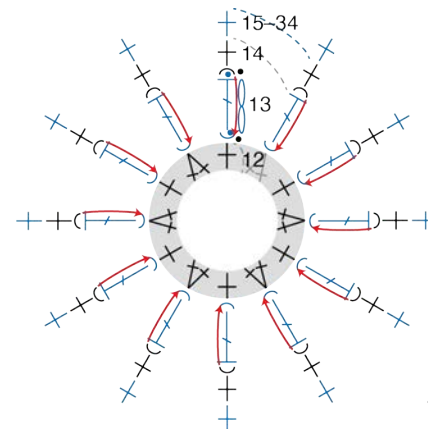


Reindeer Only: Join E with sl st to back loop of sl st join of 12th rnd.

14th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join. 12 sc. PM on last st.

Stuff mitten lightly and continue to stuff arm as you go. Work in continuous rnds.

15th to 34th rnds: 1 sc in each st around. 12 sc. Join after 34th rnd. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Santa Only:

Beard

Start with long tail to be used for sewing later. With larger hook and I, ch 18.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 17 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. *Cluster in next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * across. Turn. 9 sc and 8 clusters.

3rd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 13 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. 15 sts.

4th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. *Cluster in next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * across. Turn.

5th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 11 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. 13 sts.

6th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. *Cluster in next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * across. Turn.

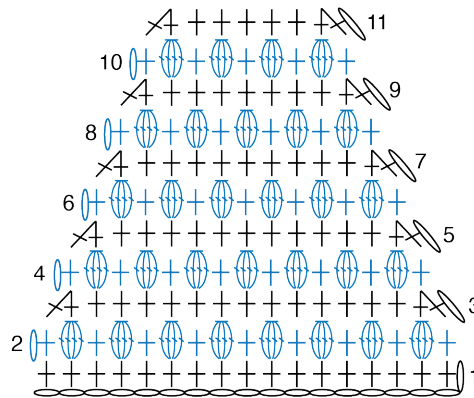
7th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 9 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. 11 sts.

8th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. *Cluster in next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * across. Turn.

9th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 7 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. 9 sts.

10th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. *Cluster in next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * across. Turn. 9 sts.

11th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 5 sts. Sc2tog. Fasten off leaving long tail for sewing. Weave tail up the side of the Beard so there is a tail at each end of the foundation ch.

MOUSTACHE (make 2)

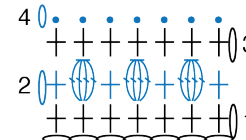
Start with long tail to use for sewing later. With larger hook and I, ch 8.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 7 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Cluster in next st. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 7 sts.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn. 7 sc.

4th row: Ch 1. Sl st each sc to end of row. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

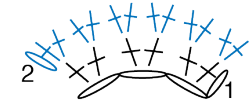

2nd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc to end of row. 12 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



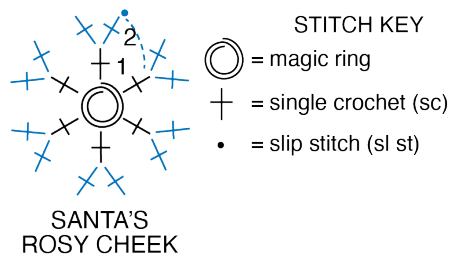

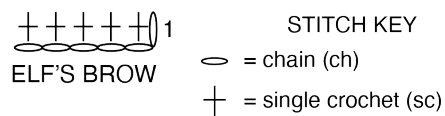

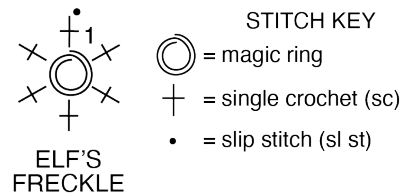
ROSY CHEEKS (make 2)

2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. Join. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



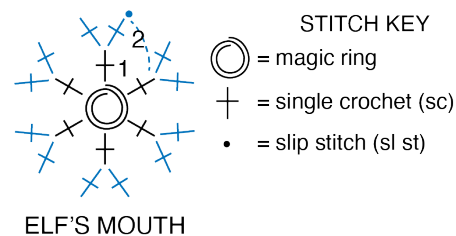
Elf Only:

 With larger hook and G, ch 6.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. 5 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



FRECKLES (make 6)
 With smaller hook and D, beg using magic loop method.
1st rnd: 6 sc in ring. Join. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

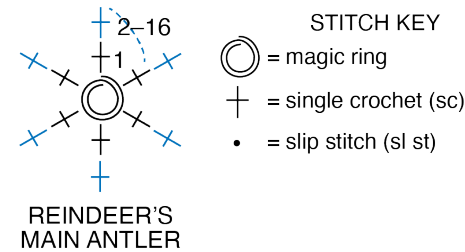


MOUTH

2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. Join. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

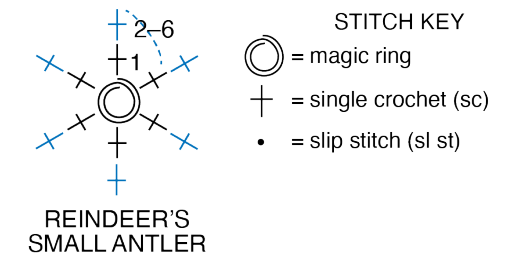


Reindeer Only:
Main Antlers (make 2)
 With smaller hook and F, beg using magic loop method.

Work in continuous rnds.
1st rnd: 8 sc in ring. 8 sc. PM for beg of rnd.
2nd to 16th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around. Join. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



Small Antlers (make 4)
 With smaller hook and F, beg using magic loop method.
 Work in continuous rnds.
1st rnd: 8 sc in ring. 8 sc. PM on last st.
2nd to 6th rnds: 1 sc in each st around. Join. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

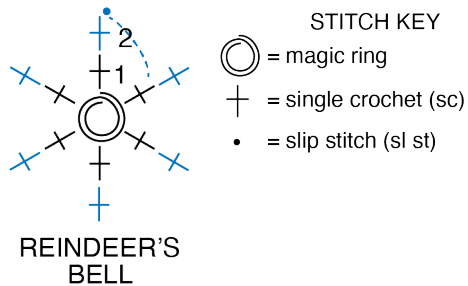


Bells (make 10)

With smaller hook and G, beg using magic loop method. Work in continuous rnds.

1st rnd: 8 sc in ring. PM on last st.

2nd rnd: 1 sc in each st around. Join. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



Assembly

Sew Hat to top of Cover, just above the Trim.

Stuff the Nose and sew on the back plate. Sew above the tissue slot.

Sew the Iris (or safety eye) to the centre of the Pupil. Sew the Pupil to the White and offset it as shown.

Sewing a little white on the Pupil gives the eyes some reflection and direction.

Santa Only: Sew the hair just below the Hat Brim. Sew the Beard below the tissue slot. Sew Nose and Moustache above the slot, tacking the Moustache ends to the Beard. Sew Tongue to bottom edge of slot, offset to the right. Sew Eyes and Rosy Cheeks to face and Ears to sides. Sew Arms to sides below Body Trim.

Elf Only: Sew 2 pieces of the ears tog. Sew Ears to sides so tips point to the back top corner of Head. Sew Hair just below Hat Brim. Sew Nose above tissue slot. Sew Mouth below slot. Sew Eyes, Eyebrows and Freckles to face. Sew Arms to sides below Body Trim.

Reindeer Only: Sew 2 Small Antlers to the Main Antler – one at the end and one at the midpoint. Sew Antlers to front of Cover above the Hat Trim. Sew Arms below bottom row of trim on sides of Cover. Sew Ears hanging downward just below Hat Trim at sides of Cover. Sew Nose above tissue slot. Sew Eyes to face. Sew Bells evenly spaced to C color band around front 3 sides of Cover.

All Versions: Sew the Candy Dish/ Pot of Gold to the mittens so it appears to be held.
