CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Grumpy

Contrast A Buff (0334) **1 ball or 28 yds/25.5 m**

Contrast B Café Latte (0360) **1 ball or 32 yds/29 m**

Contrast C Cherry Red (0319) **1 ball or 35 yds/32 m**

Contrast D Gold (0321) **1 ball or 1 yd/1 m**

Contrast E Black (0312) **1 ball or 15 yds/14 m**

Contrast F Coffee (0365) **1 ball or 20 yds/19 m**

Contrast G Soft White (0316) **1 ball or 3 yds/2.5 m**

Happy

Contrast A Buff (0334) **1 ball or 28 yds/25.5 m**

Contrast B Country Blue (0382) **1 ball or 25 yds/23.5 m**

Contrast C Café Latte (0360) **1 ball or 25 yds/23.5 m**

Contrast D Gold (0321) **1 ball or 25 yds/23.5 m**

Contrast E Black (0312) **1 ball or 15 yds/14 m**

Contrast F Coffee (0365) **1 ball or 20 yds/19 m**

Contrast G Soft White (0316) **1 ball or 3 yds/2.5 m**

Size U.S. 7 [4.5 mm] Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® stitch markers. Pair of ¼" [6 mm] safety eyes. Polyfil stuffing. Susan Bates® yarn needle.

MEASUREMENT

Approx 8" [20.5 cm] tall (including
Cap).

GAUGE

14 sc and 15 rnds = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Stuff pieces lightly. **Do not** over stuff.
- When fastening off at end of a rnd, you may wish to finish with an invisible join, as follows: Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Pull up on last loop on hook until tail is drawn all the way through last stitch. Thread tail onto yarn needle. Insert yarn needle under both strands of 2nd st of round, then insert needle down through last stitch. This creates a loop that looks like the top of a stitch. Weave in the remaining tail.

LEGS (make 2).

Beg at Boot, with F, make a [magic ring](#).

1st rnd: (RS). Work (3 sc. 2 hdc. 3 sc) in ring. Join with sl st in first sc. 8 sts.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 3 sc. 2 hdc in each of next 2 hdc (toe). 1 sc in each of last 3 sc. Join with sl st in first sc. 10 sts.

3rd and 4th rnds: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join with sl st in first sc.

5th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 3 sc. (Sc2tog) twice. 1 sc in each of last 3 sc. Join with sl st in first sc. 8 sts. Fasten off. Boot complete.

Pants: 6th rnd: With RS facing, join B with sl st in first sc of 4th rnd. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each sc around. 8 sc. **Do not** join, work in continuous rnds. PM for beg of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

7th to 9th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

10th rnd: (1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc) twice. 10 sc. Sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Hold both Legs tog, with toes facing in same direction. Sew tops of Legs tog, sewing through 2 sts at inside of each Leg and leaving 8 sts on each Leg unsewn. Stuff Legs.

Lower Tunic

With C, ch 24. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring, taking care not to twist ch.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each ch around. 24 sc. **Do not** join, work in continuous rnds. PM for beg of rnd. Move marker up as work progresses.

2nd rnd: (1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Sc2tog) 4 times. 20 sts.

3rd rnd: 1 sc in next sc. Place Tunic around top of Legs, beg at back of Legs. *Working through both thicknesses*, 1 sc in each of 8 unsewn sts of first Leg. *Working in Tunic only*, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. *Working through both thicknesses*, 1 sc in each of 8 unsewn sts of 2nd Leg. *Working in tunic only*, 1 sc in last sc. 20 sc. Fasten off.

Belt rnd: With RS facing, join E with sc at center back of Tunic. 1 sc in each remaining sc around. Join with sl st in first sc. 20 sc. Fasten off.

Upper Tunic

1st rnd: With RS facing, join C with sl st at center back of Belt. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each sc around. 20 sc. **Do not** join, work in continuous rnds. PM for beg of rnd. Move marker up as work progresses.

2nd and 3rd rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

4th rnd: 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. (Sc2tog) twice. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. (Sc2tog) twice. 1 sc in each of last 4 sc. 16 sts.

5th rnd: (Sc2tog) 8 times. 8 sts. Stuff Tunic. Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing Tunic to Head. With D, embroider a straight stitch square on center front of Belt for buckle (see photo and Diagram on page 4).

ARMS (make 2)

Beg at hand, with A, make a magic ring.

1st rnd: (RS). Work 8 sc in ring. 8 sts. **Do not** join, work in continuous rnds. PM for beg of rnd. Move marker up as work progresses.

2nd rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.

3rd rnd: (1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog) twice. 6 sts. Fasten off A.

Sleeve: 4th rnd: With RS facing, join C for Grumpy or D for Happy with sl st in first sc of 3rd rnd. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. 6 sc.

5th to 8th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around. **Do not** stuff Arm.

9th rnd: (Sc2tog) 3 times. 3 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing Arm to Tunic.

HEAD

Beg at top of Head, with A, make a magic ring.

1st rnd: (RS). Work 6 sc in ring. 6 sts. **Do not** join, work in continuous rnds. PM for beg of rnd. Move marker up as work progresses.

2nd rnd: Work 2 sc in each sc around. 12 sc.

3rd rnd: (1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. 18 sc.

4th and 5th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

6th rnd: 1 sc in each of next 9 sc. Hdc bobble in next sc (nose). 1 sc in each of last 8 sc.

7th rnd: 1 sc in each st around. Attach safety eyes, between 5th and 6th rnds, on either side of nose.

Note: Push posts of safety eyes between strands of st, not in sp between sts, to avoid allowing safety eye to sink back into Head.

8th rnd: (1 sc in next sc. Sc2tog) 6 times. 12 sts.

9th rnd: (1 sc in next sc. Sc2tog) 4 times. 8 sts.

10th rnd: 1 sc in each st around. Fasten off. Stuff Head.

CAP

Beg at top of Cap, with B for Grumpy or D for Happy, make a magic ring.

1st rnd: (RS). 4 sc in ring. **Do not** join, work in continuous rnds. PM for beg of rnd. Move marker up as work progresses.

2nd rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.

3rd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 8 sc.

4th rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.

5th rnd: (1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc) 4 times. 12 sc.

6th rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.

7th rnd: (1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc) 4 times. 16 sc.

8th rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.

9th rnd: (1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc) 4 times. 20 sc.

10th and 11th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

Fasten off.

BEARD

1st row: With G, (Ch 3. Turn chain on its side and working into back 'bump', sl st in 2nd ch from hook and next ch) 3 times. (Ch 4. Turn chain on its side and working into back 'bump', sl st in 2nd ch from hook and each of next 2 ch) 4 times. (Ch 5. Turn chain on its side and working into back 'bump', sl st in 2nd ch from hook and each of next 3 ch) 3 times.

(Ch 4. Turn chain on its side and working into back 'bump', sl st in 2nd ch from hook and each of next 2 ch) 4 times. (Ch 3. Turn chain on its side and working into back 'bump', sl st in 2nd ch from hook and next ch) 3 times. 17 beard 'chain pieces' in total.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing Beard to face.

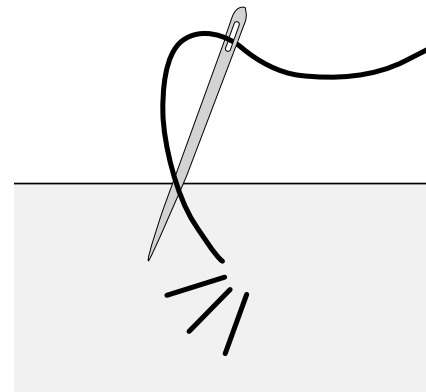
FINISHING

Sew Arms to sides of body, near top of Tunic. Sew Head to top of Tunic. Arrange Beard around chin and sides of face and sew in place. Place Cap on Head and sew in place. With E, embroider face details with straight stitches as shown in photo.
