



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

2-dc Cl (2 double crochet cluster) = Yoh and draw up a

loop in indicated st. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook. Yoh and draw up a loop in same sp.

Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 14" [35.5 cm] wide x 60" [152.5 cm] long.

GAUGE

12 dc and 6 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

RUNNER

Ch 45.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc) and in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 43 dc.

2nd row: Ch 1. Working in front loops only, 1 sl st in each dc to end of row. Turn

3rd row: Ch 1. (1 sc. Ch 4. 2-dc Cl) in first sl st. Skip next 2 sl sts. *(1 sc. Ch 4. 2-dc Cl) in first sl st. Skip next 2 sl sts. Rep from * to last sl st. 1 sc in last sl st. Turn. 14 ch-4 sps.

4th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Ch 3. 1 sc in next ch-4 sp. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

5th row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). *2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 43 dc.

MATERIALS

Red Heart® With Love™ Metallic (4.5 oz/127 g; 200 yds/183 m)

White (8010)

3 balls

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® Steel Yarn Needle.

6th to 117th rows: Rep last 4 rows 28 times more. **Do not** turn at end of last row.

EDGING

1st rnd: (RS). Ch 1, working in ends of rows, in opposite side of foundation ch and across last row, sc evenly spaced around. Join with sl st in first sc. **Do not** turn.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. Working from **left** to right, instead of from **right** to left, as usual, work 1 reverse sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
