# What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein of 254 Pumpkin

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle, Stitch markers

GAUGE: 15 ch sts = 4" (10 cm). First 2 rounds = 6" (15 cm) in diameter. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Spider Web Table Topper

Add a crafty covering to your table of treats with the perfect spider web topper. The open webbing is easy to crochet and will be used year after year during the Halloween season.

Table Topper measures 54" (137 cm) in diameter

### **Special Abbreviations**

Picot: Ch 3, slip st in 3rd ch from hook.

#### **TABLE TOPPER**

Ch 4; join with a slip st in first ch to form ring. **Round 1 (right side):** \*Ch 4, place marker (pm), ch 3, pm, ch 4, slip st in ring; repeat from \* 5 times; join with a slip st in first ch – 6 large loops.

**Round 2:** Slip st in each ch to next marked ch, \*ch 5, pm, ch 6, pm, ch 5, slip st in next marked st, ch 2, slip st in next marked st on next large loop; repeat from \* around.

Round 3: Slip st in each ch to next marked ch, \*ch 6, pm, ch 10, pm, ch 6, slip st in next marked st, ch 5, slip st in next marked st on next large loop; repeat from \* around.

**Round 4:** Slip st in each ch to next marked ch, \*ch 7, pm, ch 14, pm, ch 7, slip st in next marked st, ch 9, slip st in next marked st on next large loop; repeat from \* around.

**Round 5:** Slip st in each ch to next marked ch, \*ch 8, pm, ch 19, pm, ch 8, slip st in next marked st, ch 13, slip st in next marked st on next large loop; repeat from \* around.

Round 6: Slip st in each ch to next marked ch, \*ch 9, pm, ch 25, pm, ch 9, slip st in next marked st, ch 18, slip st in next marked st on next large loop; repeat from \* around.

Round 7: Slip st in each ch to next marked ch, \*ch 10, pm, ch 30, pm, ch 10, slip st in next marked st, ch 24, slip st in next marked st on next large loop; repeat from \* around.

Round 8: Slip st in each ch to next marked ch, \*ch 11, pm, ch 36, pm, ch 11, slip st in next marked st, ch 29, slip st in next marked st; repeat from \* around.

Round 9: Slip st in each ch to next marked ch, \*ch 12, pm, ch 42, pm, ch 12, slip st in next marked st, ch35, slip st in next marked st on next large loop; repeat from \* around.

next large loop; repeat from \* around. Round 10: Slip st in each ch to next marked ch, \*ch 13, pm, ch 42, pm, ch 13, slip st in next marked st, ch 41, slip st in next marked st on next large loop; repeat from \* around. Round 11: Ch 1 (does not count as first st), pm, \*slip st in each of next 42 ch, ending at next marker, \*ch 42, slip st in ch after next marked st on next loop, slip st in each of next 41 ch. ending at next marker; repeat from \* 4 times, ch 42; join with a slip st in first slip st – 504 sts; 6 sets of 42 slip sts; 6 ch-42 loops) Round 12: Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), skip next 2 sts, \*dc in next st, ch 2, skip next 2 sts; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-5 – 168 ch-2 spaces.

Round 13: Slip st in first ch-2 space, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 space, 3 dc in each ch-2 space around – 504 dc.

Round 14: \*Ch 3, skip next 3 dc, (tr, picot, tr) in space before next dc, ch 3, skip next 3 dc, slip st in space before next dc; repeat from \* around. Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

ch = chain; dc = double crochet; st(s) =
stitch(es); tr = treble crochet; () = work
directions in parentheses into same st; [] =
work directions in brackets the number of
times specified; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever
follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
