## What you will need:

RED HEART® Gumdrop®: 1 ball of 620 Cherry A

RED HEART® Soft®: 1 ball each of 2515 Turquoise B, and 9528 Lilac C

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:  
4.25 mm [US G-6]

**GAUGE:** Finished square = 4" x 4" (10 x 10 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Gumdrop®, Art. E800 available in multicolor 4 oz (113 g), 204 yd (187 m) balls



RED HEART® Soft®, Art. E728 available in solid color 5 oz (141 g), 256 yd (234 m), print 4 oz (113 g), 204 yd (187 m), and heather 4oz (113g), 212 yd (194m) balls

# Single Square Coasters

*Begin your granny-making adventure by making grannies to use as coasters. Use a multi yarn for color interest, or make them in assorted solid colors in line with your décor.*

Coaster measures 4" x 4" (10 x 10 cm)

## Color Sequence

### Coaster #1:

Rounds 1-4: B.

### Coaster #2:

Rounds 1-2: A.

Rounds 3-4: B.

### Coaster #3:

Rounds 1-2: A.

Rounds 3-4: C.

## COASTER

With first color, ch 4; slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1 (right side):** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 2 dc in ring, \*ch 3, 3 dc in ring; repeat from \* twice, ch 3; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-3 – 12 dc; 4 ch-3 spaces. Fasten off.

**Round 2:** Slip st in next 2 dc and ch-3 space, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in same ch-3 space, \*(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 space; repeat from \* twice, join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off if changing color.

**Round 3:** Slip st in next 2 dc and corner ch-3 space or join next color with slip st in any corner ch-3 space, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in same ch-3 space, \*3 dc between next two 3-dc groups\*\*, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next corner ch-3 space; repeat from \* around, ending last repeat at \*\*; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-3.

**Round 4:** Slip st in next 2 dc and ch-3 space, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in same ch-3 space, \*[3 dc between next two 3-dc groups] twice\*\*, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next corner ch-3 space; repeat from \* around, ending last repeat at \*\*; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = color A, B, C; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; st(s) = stitch (es); ( ) = work directions in parentheses into same st; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
