What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby™: 1 ball 10 Coconut

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle 3 yds red worsted weight yarn

GAUGE: 4 rows = $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (6.5) cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Scrubby™, Art. E833 available in solids 3.5 oz (100 g), 92 yd (85 m) and prints 3 oz (85 g), 78 yd (71 m) balls



Crochet Baseball Scrubby

Little baseball sluggers will enjoy bath time using this baseball Scrubby. It can be crocheted quickly, so you can make one for each member of the team.

Scrubby measures 51/2" (14 cm) in diameter.

SCRUBBY Baseball (make 2)

Ch 4.

Round 1: Work 11 dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning skipped ch count as first dc); join with slip st in top of beginning ch-12 dc.

Round 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in same st as join, 2 dc in each remaining dc around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-24

Round 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, *dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-36 dc.

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, *dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-48 dc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing on 1 piece.

FINISHING


Referring to photograph as a guide, embroider ball stitching with red yarn and chain stitches.

With wrong sides held together and red sts matching, sew pieces together. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain(s): dc = double crochet: st(s) = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
