What you will need:

COATS® Crème de la Crème®:
1 ball 951 Jadetones **A**

RED HEART® Scrubby Cotton™: 1 ball 7586 Jade **B**

Susan Bates® Double End Crochet Hook: 6mm [US J-10]

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 15 sts = 4" (10 cm);
20 rows = 4" (10 cm) with
double end hook. **CHECK
YOUR GAUGE. Use any size
hook to obtain the gauge.**

SHOP KIT

Tunisian Square Scrubby

Combine cotton yarn with Scrubby Cotton for a textured cloth that's a natural for bathing. We've used two coordinating colors, but you can experiment with whatever colors that please you.

Scrubby measures 6½" x 6½" (16.5 x 16.5 cm).

Notes

1. Scrubby is worked with double end crochet hook, edging is worked with standard hook.
2. In all odd-numbered rows, loops are picked up on hook, slid to opposite end, and the hook is then turned. Loops are worked off the hook in even-numbered rows.
3. If you hold the hook in your right hand, you will work the odd-numbered rows from right to left. Work the even-numbered rows from left to right. If you hold the hook in your left hand, work the rows in the opposite directions.
4. When instructed to pick up a loop in horizontal stitches, insert hook under top strand only.
5. Do not cut or fasten off color not in use until instructed.

SCRUBBY

With **A** and double end hook, ch 25.

Row 1: Working in back bars, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, yarn over and pull up a loop, *insert hook in next ch, yarn over and pull up a loop; repeat from * across; leave all loops on hook—25 loops on hook. Slide sts to opposite end of hook and turn.

Row 2: Place **B** on hook with slip knot and draw through first loop, *yarn over, draw through 2 loops; repeat from * across—1 loop on hook. Do not slide sts or turn hook.

Row 3: With **B**, ch 1, *yarn over, skip next horizontal st, insert hook in next horizontal st and pull up a loop; repeat from * across; leave all loops on hook. Slide all sts to opposite end of hook and turn.

Row 4: With **A**, yarn over, draw through first loop on hook, *yarn over, draw through 2 loops; repeat from * across—1

loop on hook. Do not slide sts or turn hook.

Row 5: With **A**, ch 1, *insert hook in next horizontal st, pull up a loop; repeat from * across. Slide sts to opposite end of hook and turn.

Row 6: With **B**, yarn over, draw through first loop on hook, *yarn over, draw through 2 loops; repeat from * across. Do not slide sts or turn hook.

Rows 7–30: Repeat Rows 3–6 six times.

Rows 31 and 32: Repeat Rows 3 and 4.

Bind Off Row: With **A**, ch 1, slip st in each horizontal st across—1 loop on hook. Fasten off **B**.

Edging

Place **A**-colored loop on standard hook.

First Side Edging: Ch 1, working in ends of rows, sc evenly spaced down side edge; join with slip st in first foundation ch. Fasten off.

2nd Side Edging: With right side of bottom edge facing, join **A** with slip st in last foundation ch, ch 1, working in ends of rows, sc evenly spaced up side edge; join with slip st in end of Row 33. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B = Color A, Color B; **ch** = chain(s);
sc = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es);
* = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.



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
