## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Scrubby™:** 1 ball each 620 Lime **A** and 940 Capri **B**  
OR 1 ball each 501 Ocean **A** and 620 Lime **B**

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical for this project.



**RED HEART® Scrubby™**, Art. E833  
available in solids 3.5 oz (100 g), 92 yd (85 m), prints 3.0 oz (85 g) 78 yds (71 m) balls

# Give a Hand Scrubby

*This scrubby is perfect for anywhere in the house or outside to clean up the patio. Every member of the family will love using this bright colored scrubby to make cleaning faster and easier. Simply throw it in the washing machine to have it ready for the next cleaning duty.*

SHOP KIT

**Scrubby measures about 5½" [14 cm] across hand and 6½" [16.5 cm] high, not including hanging loop.**

## Special Stitches

**join with sc** = Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

**sc2tog (single crochet 2 stitches together)** = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**sc3tog (single crochet 3 stitches together)** = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

## Notes

1. Scrubby is worked, back and forth in rows, beginning at wrist.
2. Thumb is worked over the first 6 stitches of the hand. The hand is continued then each of the next three fingers are worked over 3 stitches of the last row of the hand. The pinky is worked over the last 2 stitches of the last row the hand.

## HAND

Beginning at wrist, with **A**, ch 12

**Row 1 (right side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across—11 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st to last st, 2 sc in last st—13 sc.

**Rows 4 and 5:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to last st, 2 sc in last st—14 sc.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each remaining st across—15 sc.

**Rows 8 and 9:** Repeat Rows 6 and 7—17 sc.

**Row 10:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

## Shape Thumb

**Row 11 (right side):** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 4 sts, sc2tog; leave last 11 sts unworked for fingers—5 sc.

**Row 12:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts—4 sc.

**Row 13:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sts, sc2tog; work 3 slip sts evenly spaced down side edge of thumb to just before first unworked st of Row 10.

Do not fasten off.

## Continue Hand

**Row 11 Continued (right side):** Sc in first unworked st of Row 10 and in each unworked st of Row 10 across—11 sc.

**Row 12:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

## Index Finger

**Row 13 (right side):** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts; leave last 8 sts unworked for remaining 3 fingers—3 sc.

**Rows 14–16:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 17:** Ch 1, turn, sc3tog—1 sc.  
Fasten off.

## Middle Finger

**Row 13 (right side):** With right side facing, join **A** with sc in first unworked st of Row 12 following index finger, sc in next 2 sts; leave last 5 sts unworked for remaining 2 fingers—3 sc.

**Rows 14–18:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 19:** Ch 1, turn, sc3tog—1 sc.  
Fasten off.

Continued...



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## Ring Finger

**Row 13 (right side):** With right side facing, join **A** with sc in first unworked st of Row 12 following middle finger, sc in next 2 sts; leave last 2 sts unworked for pinky—3 sc.

**Rows 14–17:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 18:** Ch 1, turn, sc3tog—1 sc.

Fasten off.

## Pinky

**Row 13 (right side):** With right side facing, join **A** with sc in first unworked st of Row 12 following ring finger, sc in next st—2 sc.

**Rows 14 and 15:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 16:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog—1 sc.

Fasten off.

## EDGING AND HANGING LOOP

With right side facing, join **B** with sc in lower corner below pinky, sc evenly spaced all the way around working 2 sc at the tip of each finger and thumb, 2 sc at each lower corner, and 1 slip st between fingers; join with slip st in first sc, ch 12 (for hanging loop), slip st in same sc again.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A** and **B** = Color A and Color B; **ch** = chain;  
**sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es).
