## What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby Smoothie®: 1 ball 9205 Aqua

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 13 dc = 4'' [10 cm]; $5\frac{1}{2}$  rows = 4'' [10 cm] in single crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Lattice Washcloth

Make a whole pile of washcloths for vour kitchen so you'll always have a nice, cotton cloth for washing veggies or wiping up counters.

Washcloth measures 7" [18 cm] x 7" Γ18 cm1.

#### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**Bpsc:** (back post single crochet) Insert hook from back to front then to back, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook. Skip st in front of Bpsc.

**Fpsc:** (front post single crochet) Insert hook from front to back then to front, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook. Skip st behind Fpsc.

#### reverse sc (reverse single crochet) =

Work single crochet in opposite direction from which you would usually work (left to right if you are right-handed and right to left if you are left-handed). This st is also known as crab st. It creates a ropelike twisted single crochet edging.

## **WASHCLOTH**

Ch 26.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (skipp ch count as dc) dc in each ch across

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, \*Bps Fpsc; repeat from \* to last st, sc in Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, dc in each st across. Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, \*Fpsc, Bpsc; repeat from \* to last st, sc in last st.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Repeat Rows 2-5 until piece measures 7" [18 cm] from beginning, ending with Row 2 or 4.

## **Edging**

Ch 1. turn to work along outside edges, work reverse sc evenly spaced around, working (sc, ch 1, sc) in each corner, slip st in first st. Fasten off.

### **FINISHIING**

Weave in ends.

#### **Abbreviations**

ch = chain; cm = centimeters; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
