



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 18" [45.5 cm] long x 15" [38 cm] wide.

GAUGE

12 sc and 15 rounds = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Cat Pouch is worked in a spiral. **Do not** join rounds (rnds). There are no chain worked at beginning (beg) of rnd unless otherwise indicated; simply work directly into next stitch (st) (noting marker to indicate end of rnd will move up each rnd).

Chain (Ch) 53.

1st rnd: 1 single crochet (sc) in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to last ch. 3 sc in last ch. *Working into remaining loops along opposite side of foundation ch*, 1 sc in each ch to last ch. 2 ch in last ch. Place marker on last st. 106 sc.

2nd rnd: 1 sc in each sc around. Move up marker.

Repeat (Rep) 2nd rnd until work from beginning (beg) measures 22" [56 cm].

Slip stitch (sl st) into first sc. Fasten off.

Fold top edge back 4" [10 cm] for a sturdier opening to Cat Pouch and sew in position to Wrong Side (WS).



MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® (5 oz/141 g; 236 yds/215 m)

Retro Stripes (4971)

2 balls

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® stitch marker. Susan Bates® yarn needle.

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side
