



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

## MEASUREMENTS

Hood is approx 5½" [14 cm] at its deepest point x 5" [12.5 cm] tall.

## GAUGE

12 sc and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** Ch 2 at beg of rows **does not** count as dc. First dc of row is worked directly into last dc of previous row.

## HOOD

With A, ch 32.

See diagram on page 2.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 dc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 30 dc.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 dc in each of next 14 dc. 2 dc in each of next 2 dc. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn. 32 dc.

**3rd row:** Ch 2. 1 dc in each of next 15 dc. 2 dc in each of next 2 dc. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn. 34 dc.

**4th and 5th rows:** Ch 2. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.

**6th row:** Ch 2. 1 dc in each of next 13 dc. (Dc2tog) 4 times. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn. 30 sts.

**7th row:** Ch 2. 1 dc in each of next 13 sts. (Dc2tog) twice. 1 dc in each st to end of row. Turn. 28 sts.

**8th row:** Ch 2. 1 dc in each of next 12 dc. (Dc2tog) twice. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn. 26 sts.

## MATERIALS

**Red Heart® Super Saver®** (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

**Contrast A** Cherry Red (0319) **1 ball or 73 yds/67 m**

**Contrast B** Soft White (0316) **1 ball or 36.5 yds/33.5 m**

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle.

**9th row:** Ch 2. 1 dc in each of next 11 dc. (Dc2tog) twice. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn. 24 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Fold top of Hood, aligning sts of last row. Sew top of Hood closed using long tail.

### CAPE

With RS facing, join A with sl st to rem loop of foundation ch at bottom left of Hood. See diagram on page 3.

**1st row:** Ch 2. 2 dc in first ch. \*1 dc in next ch. 2 dc in next ch. Rep from \* to last ch. 1 dc in last ch. Turn. 45 dc.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 2. \*1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 2 dc in next dc. Rep from \* end of row. **Do not** turn. 60 dc.

### Cape Edging

**Front edging:** (RS). Ch 1. Working up right front edge of Hood, Work 24 sc evenly to top of Hood (2 sc in side of each row). Work 24 sc evenly down left side. Join B with sl st to first dc of last row of Cape.

**1st rnd:** With B, skip first st. \*5 dc in next st. Skip next st. Sl st in next st. Skip next st. Rep from \* along bottom of Cape, up right front edge and down left front edge. Join with sl st to last st. Fasten off.

### TIES (Make 2)

**Make Bobble:** Holding 2 strands of B tog, ch 4. [*Yoh and draw up a long loop in 4th ch from hook (same height as ch-3). Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook 4 times. Yoh and draw through rem 5 loops on hook.* Ch 1. Sl st in 4th ch from hook (same sp as Bobble just worked) to create Bobble end. Ch 20. Fasten off leaving long tail. Using tail, attach each tie to front edge of Hood at 1st row. Weave in ends.
