



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** =

Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Dc2tog** = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch. Yoh and draw a loop through 2 loops on hook) twice. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**Rem** = Remain(ing)

**Rep** = Repeat

**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Scbl** = Single crochet in back loop only

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

**WS** = Wrong side

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 13" [33 cm] circumference x 5½" [14 cm] high.

## GAUGE

12 sc and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Ribbing:** Ch 8.

See diagram on page 2.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 7 sc.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row 35 times more. 36 rows total.

**Do not** fasten off.

**Join ribbing:** Holding WS tog and working through both thicknesses of foundation ch and last row of ribbing, work 1 sc in each sc to end of row. **Do not** fasten off.

Turn Ribbing sideways to work along straight top edge of Ribbing.

## Hat Body

See diagram on page 2.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. Work 36 sc around straight top edge of Ribbing. (1 sc into side of each row of ribbing). Join with sl st to first sc. 36 sc.

## MATERIALS

**Red Heart® Super Saver™** (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

White (0311)

**1 ball or 85 yds/78 m**

**Note:** 1 ball will make 4 Hats.

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle. Susan Bates® stitch markers.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. 72 sc.

**3rd to 6th rnds:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout). 1 dc in each st around. Join with sl st to top of beg ch 3.

**Shape top: 7th rnd:** Ch 3. 1 dc in next dc. Dc2tog. \*1 dc in each of next 2 dc. Dc2tog. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. 54 sts.

**8th rnd:** Ch 3. Dc2tog. \*1 dc in next dc. Dc2tog. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. 36 sts.

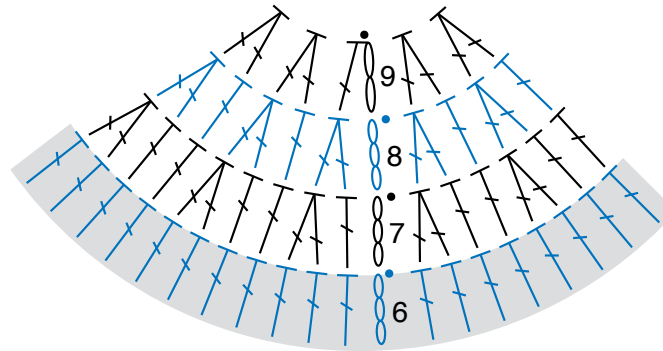
**9th rnd:** Ch 2. Yoh and draw up a loop in next st. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice – beg dc2tog made. \*Dc2tog. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to top of first st. 18 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long end. Thread end through rem sts and draw up tightly. Fasten to secure.

## Ties

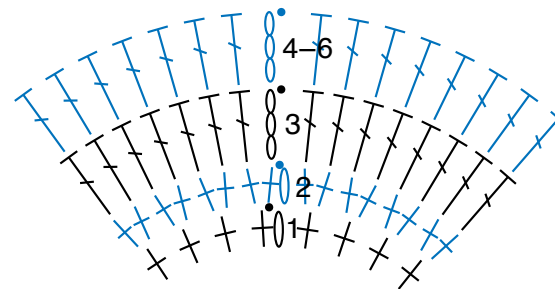
Lay Hat flat with seam of Ribbing at center back and place markers at each side edge of Ribbing.

Join yarn with sl st at marker. Ch 25. Fasten off.

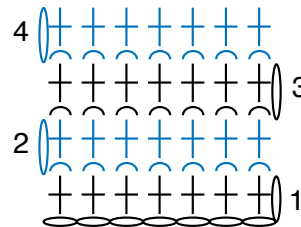
Rep for second Tie.
