



MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Contrast A 1 (1-1) ball or
Cherry Red (0319) 22 (45-107) yds/20 (41-98) m

Contrast B 1 (1-1) ball or
Soft White (0316) 17 (34-81) yds/16 (31-74) m

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Inc = Increase(ing)

Pat = Pattern

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Scbl = Single crochet in back loop only of next stitch

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

SIZES

To fit pet neck circumference measurements:

S 10" [25.5 cm]

M 15" [38 cm]

L 22" [56 cm]

GAUGE

12 sc and 15 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

The instruction are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sized the instructions will be written thus (). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. For ease in working, circle all number pertaining to your size.

Notes:

- Neckerchief is worked on the bias.
- To join new color, work to last loops on hook of previous color. Yoh with new color, draw through rem loops and proceed with new color.
- Carry color not in use loosely across top edge of work.
- Customize Neckerchief fit by working until Top Edge is appropriate length to fit around pet's neck circumference.
- Ties are added in finishing for securing Neckerchief in place.

Stripe Pat

With A, work 2 rows.

With B, work 2 rows.

These 4 rows form Stripe Pat.

NECKERCHIEF

With A, ch 2.

1st row: (RS). 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of first 2 sc. 2 scbl in last sc. Join B. Turn. 4 sc.

3rd row: With B, ch 1. 2 scbl in first sc. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn. 5 sc.

4th row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc to last sc. 2 scbl in last sc. Join A. Turn. 6 sc.

First 4 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep 3rd and 4th rows, inc 1 st each row, until Top Edge (edge where color not in use is carried across) measures approx **10 (15-22)**" [**25.5 (38-36)** cm] or desired length, ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Ties: **1st row:** With A, ch 20 (Tie).

*With RS facing, and working along Top Edge of Neckerchief, work sc evenly across, working sts around sides of sts and strands of yarn that were carried across Top Edge to enclose them. Ch 20 (Tie). Fasten off.

Fringe: Cut lengths of both A and B 5" [12.5 cm long]. Taking 2 strands of either A or B, fold in half and knot into fringe at end of corresponding color stripe along first edge of Neckerchief (as shown in photo). Repeat same fringe pattern (alternating A and B strands) as established along first edge, along second side edge of Neckerchief (as shown in photo). If desired, steam fringe lightly to relax yarn until fringe hangs freely. Trim fringe evenly.
