



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

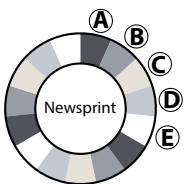

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® O'Go™ (5 oz/141 g; 236 yds/215 m)

Sizes **S** **M** **L** **XL**
 Newsprint (7124) **2** **2** **3** **3** **O'Gos**



Sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hooks **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch markers. Yarn needle. 2 sets of sew-on snap fasteners or hook and loop fasteners.

SIZES

To fit chest measurement

S **10"** [25.5 cm]
M **16"** [40.5 cm]
L **19"** [48 cm]
XL **24"** [61 cm]

GAUGES

14 dc and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm] with
 larger hook.
 Motif = 3¼" [8.5 cm] square with
 larger hook.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use. Follow color guide shown in Materials section for each O'Go (Contrast A, B, C, D and E). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label each bag A, B, C, D and E
- Start crocheting!

MOTIF

Note: Ch 3 at beg of rows counts as dc.

With larger hook and Color 1, ch 4.
1st rnd: [2 dc (Ch 3. 3 dc) 3 times] in 4th ch from hook. Ch 1. Join with hdc in top of first dc.

2nd rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc around post of joining hdc. [1 dc in each of next 3 dc. (2 dc. Ch 3. 2 dc) in next ch-3 sp] 3 times. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. 2 dc in same sp as first dc. Ch 3. Join with sl st to top of first dc. Fasten off.

3rd rnd: Join A with sl st to any corner ch-3 sp. Ch 1. (1 sc. Ch 2. 1 sc) in same sp as sl st. [1 sc in each of next 7 dc. (1 sc. Ch 2. 1 sc) in next ch-3 sp] 3 times. 1 sc in each of next 7 dc. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

With B as Color 1, make 7 (10-12-16) Motifs.

With C as Color 1, make 4 (8-12-16) Motifs.

With D as Color 1, make 6 (7-10-17) Motifs.

With E as Color 1, make 4 (7-8-13) Motifs.

Following assembly Diagrams on page 3, join Motifs into strips as needed according to size, then join to make chest and neck opening.

Joining Motifs: With RS of matching color Motifs tog, join A with sl st to corner ch-2 sp. *Working through both thicknesses*, work 1 sc in same sp as sl st and each sc to next ch-2 sp. 1 sc in next ch-2 sp. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Pin Coat to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Neck ribbing: With rem yarn of any color and smaller hook, ch 5 (6-7-7) loosely.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 4 (5-6-6) sc.

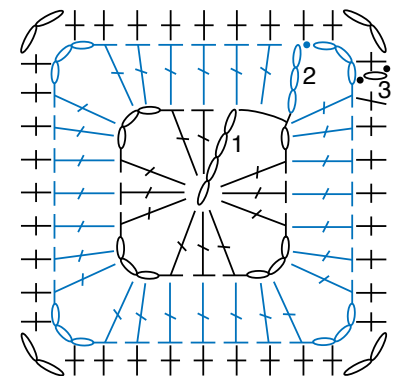
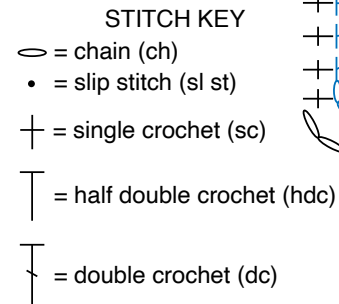
2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep 2nd row until work, when slightly stretched, measures length to fit around neck opening. Beg at center chest area, sew in place as you work. Fasten off. Sew side edges tog.

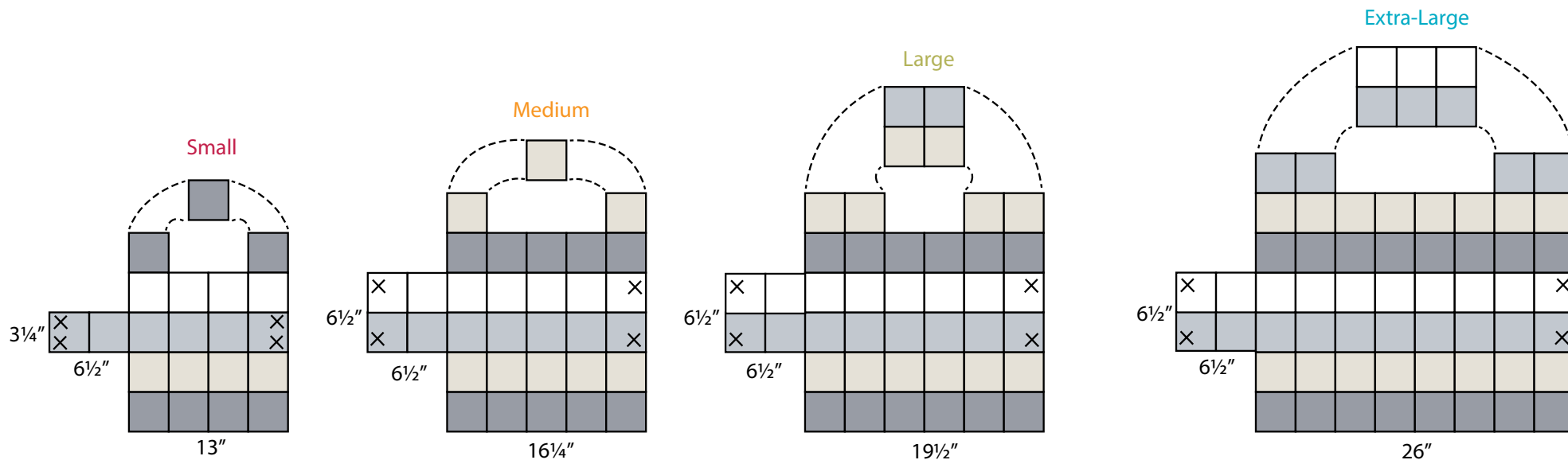
Outer edging: 1st rnd: Beg at center chest area, with RS facing, join rem yarn of any color with sl st to seam between 2 Motifs. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. Work in sc around entire edge of Coat, working 3 sc at outer corners and sc2tog at inner corners. Join with sl st to first sc.

2nd and 3rd rnds: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. Work in sc around entire edge of Coat, working 3 sc at outer corners and sc2tog at inner corners. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off at end of 3rd rnd.

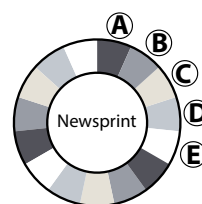
Try Coat on. Mark position for fasteners. Sew fasteners in place.
