## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** =

Approximately

**Beg** = Begin(ning)

**Ch** = Chain(s)

## SIZES

**Small** and **Medium**.

**To fit head circumference:**

**20 (22)" [51 (56) cm]**

## GAUGE

10 hdc and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm]  
in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** This project is worked top-down in the round. The right side of the work is always facing.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**Inc (Increase):** Work 2 half-double  
crochet in stitch or sp indicated.

**FPhdc (Front-post half double  
crochet):** Work a half-double  
crochet around the front of the  
post of the stitch indicated.

**BPhdc (Back-post half double  
crochet):** Work a half-double  
crochet around the back of the  
post of the stitch indicated.

## HAT

### Crown

Make an adjustable ring as follows:  
Wrap yarn around your finger with  
the yarn tail to the left and under  
the working yarn. Insert hook  
through the circle from front to  
back. Yarn over using the working  
yarn and pull through loop; ch 1,  
release circle around finger gently.

## MATERIALS

**Red Heart® With Love™** (7 oz/198 g; 370 yds/338 m)

Sizes	S	M	
Cameo (1711)	1	1	ball
Tan (1308)	1	1	ball
Iced Aqua (1502)	1	1	ball

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain  
gauge.** Yarn needle.

**1st rnd:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc), 9 hdc into adjustable ring, sl st to first hdc to join rnd; tighten yarn tail to close the ring – 10 hdc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 2, hdc in first sp (counts as inc), inc in each sp between each hdc around; sl st to first hdc to join rnd – 20 hdc.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 2, hdc in sp between each st around; sl st to first hdc to join rnd.

**4th rnd:** Ch 2, hdc in first sp (counts as inc), hdc in next sp, \*inc in next sp, hdc in next sp; repeat from \* around; sl st to first hdc to join rnd – 30 hdc.

**5th rnd:** Rep 3rd rnd.

**6th rnd:** Ch 2, hdc in first sp (counts as inc), hdc in next 2 sps, \*inc in next sp, hdc in next 2 sps; repeat from \* around; sl st to first hdc to join rnd–40 hdc.

**7th rnd:** Rep 3rd rnd.

**Size S only: 8th rnd:** Ch 2, hdc in first sp (counts as inc), hdc in next 7 sps, \*inc in next sp, hdc in next 7 sps; repeat from \* around; sl st to first hdc to join rnd–45 hdc.

**9th rnd:** Ch 2, hdc in first sp (counts as inc), hdc in each sp around; sl st to first hdc to join rnd – 46 hdc.

**Size M Only: 8th rnd:** Ch 2, hdc in first sp (counts as inc), hdc in next 3 sps, \*inc in next sp, hdc in next 3 sps; repeat from \* around; sl st to first hdc to join rnd–50 sts.

**9th rnd:** Rep 3rd rnd.

**All Sizes:** Rep 3rd rnd **8 (11)** times more.

## Brim

**1st rnd:** Ch 2 (counts as BPhdc), FPhdc in next st, \*BPhdc in next st, FPhdc in next st; repeat from \* around; sl st to first st to join rnd.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 2 (counts as BPhdc), FPhdc in next FPhdc, \*BPhdc in next BPhdc, FPhdc in next FPhdc; repeat from \* around; sl st to first st to join rnd.

**3rd rnd:** Rep 2nd rnd.

Fasten off. Break yarn, leaving a 6" (15 cm) tail.

## FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in yarn ends. Block as desired.
