## One Warm Coat® Crocheted Scarf

This crocheted scarf was designed using the special shade of Heartfelt Super Saver yarn. Crochet one (or more) and donate it to the One Warm Coat Drive in your community to help keep America warm.

Designed by Bobbi Anderson.

Scarf measures 5½" x 60".

RED HEART® "Super Saver®": 1 skein 906 Heartfelt.

Crochet Hook: 6.5mm [US K-10.5].

Yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 16 sts = 5"; 4 rows =  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ": in pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## **SCARF**

**Foundation-Row:** Ch 165; sc in 5th ch from hook, [ch 3, skip next 3 ch, sc in next ch] 40 times – 41 loops. Turn. **Round 1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) all in first ch-3 loop, \* [ch 1, 3 dc in next loop] 40 times \*\*, [ch 3, 3 dc] twice all in last loop; work on opposite side of Foundation Row, repeat from \* to \*\*; ch 3; join with a slip st in top of ch-3 – 84 groups of 3-dc.

**Round 2:** Slip st to next ch-3 space, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) all in same space, ch 1, \* 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1; repeat from \* to next ch-3 space; [(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 space, ch 1] twice; repeat from \* to last ch-3 space; (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in last ch-3 space, ch 1; join.

Rounds 3 and 4: Slip st to next ch-3 space, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) all in same space, ch 1, \* 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1 \*\*; repeat from \* to next ch-3 space; (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 space, ch 1; repeat from \* around, end at \*\*; join.

Round 5: Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, sc in each dc, 5 sc in each ch-3 space, and sc in each ch-1 space around; join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

**ABBREVIATIONS: ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch (es); \* **or** \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
