Knit Monogram Ear Warmers

Add a personal note to your ear warming headband with an easy-to-embroider monogram. Simply knit your ear warmer first, then use our photographed alphabet and charts as guides for your embroidery. Pattern is given in three sizes and stretches to fit a range of head sizes.

What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft: 1 ball each 9440 Light Grey Heather **A** and 9518 Teal **B**

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 4.5mm [US 7]

Susan Bates® split lock stitch markers

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 18 sts and 32 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Seed St. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Soft®, Art. E728, available in solid color 5 oz (141 g), 256 yd (234 m) and print 4 oz (113 g), 204 yd (187 m) balls

SHOP KIT

Ear warmer measures 15½ (18, 20½)" (39.5 (46, 52) cm) in circumference and 3" (7.5 cm) wide.

SPECIAL TECHNIQUE

Stretchy Bind-off: K1, * k1, slide st just made back to left needle, k2tog through the back loop; repeat from * across. When 1 st remains, fasten off.

SEED STITCH

Row 1 (wrong side): * K1, p1; repeat from * to end.

Row 2: * P1, k1; repeat from * to end. Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for Seed st.

EAR WARMER

With **B**, Cast on 70 (82, 94) sts. Cut **B** and join **A**.

Row 1 (right side): K1, work in Seed st to last st, k1.

Row 2: P1, work in Seed st to last st, p1.

Row 3: K1, work 20 (26, 32) sts in Seed st, place marker, work 14 sts in Stockinette st, place marker, work 34 (40, 46) sts in Seed st, k1.

Row 4: P1, work 34 (40, 46) sts in Seed st, slip marker, work 14 sts in Stockinette st, slip marker, work 20 (26, 32) sts in Seed st, p1.

Work 16 more rows in established patterns, keeping first and last st in Stockinette st.

Last 2 rows: Repeat Rows 1 and 2.

Cut **A** and join **B**.

Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

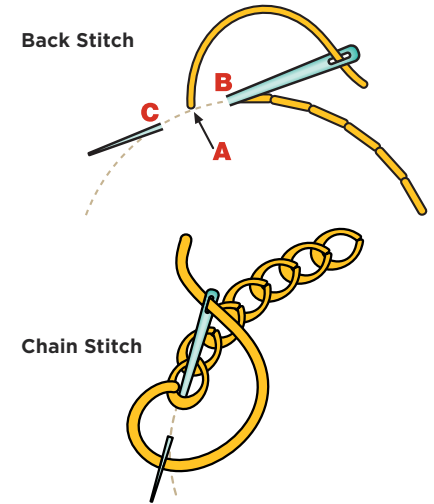
Using **B** and yarn needle, embroider letter of choice using chain st and back st following charts.

Sew short ends of ear warmers together.

Weave in all loose ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B = Color A, Color B; **k** = knit; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch (es); * **or** ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
