## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Evermore™:**  
1 ball 9932 Cabana

**Susan Bates® Knitting  
Needles:** 8mm [US 11]

Cable needle  
Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 12 sts = 4" [10 cm],  
16 rows = 4" [10cm] in 1x1 Rib,  
slightly stretched. **CHECK  
YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size  
needles to obtain the gauge.

# Twist Headband

Keep warm, with a twist! This quick headband is a great alternative to hats.

**Directions are for adult's size Small/Medium; changes for Medium/Large are in parentheses. When only 1 number is given, it applies to both sizes.**

**Headband Adult Small/Medium (Medium/Large)**

**Finished circumference:** 20 (22)"  
[51 (56) cm]  
**Width:** 3½" [9cm]

## NOTE

Slip all sts purlwise with yarn in back.

## HEADBAND

Cast on 14 sts.

**Row 1:** Slip 1, \*k1, p1; repeat from \* to last st, k1.

Repeat Row 1 until piece measures 10 (11)" [25.5 (28)cm].

**Next Row (Cable Cross):** Slip 1, slide next 6 sts onto cable needle and hold in front of work; \*k1, p1; repeat from \* to last st; work sts from cable needle in rib pattern as established, k1.

Repeat Row 1 until piece measures 20 (22)" [51 (56)cm].

Bind off loosely.

## Finishing

Sew short ends of headband together. Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**cm** = centimeters; **K** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.



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
