What you will need:

RED HEART[®] Super Saver[®]: 1 skein 312 Black A and RED HEART[®] Boutique[™] Ribbons[®]: 1 ball 1933 Grapevine B

Susan Bates $^{\otimes}$ Circular Knitting Needle: 5.5mm [US 9] – 24" (61 cm). Susan Bates $^{\otimes}$ Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

Gauge: 17 sts = 4" (10 cm); 23 rows = 4" (10 cm) with A in St st. Exact gauge is not crucial to this pattern.

SHOP KIT



Just-the-Essentials Baglet

Ruffled Boutique Ribbons yarn is combined with a plain yarn to create a special knit evening bag for your next event or to give as a thoughtful gift to a stylish damsel. Baglet measures 4" (10 cm) wide x 6" (15 cm) high.

NOTE

Baglet is made in one piece and then folded and sewn at bottom and one side.

Seed Stitch

Row 1: * K1, p1; repeat from * across. Repeat Row 1 for Seed st.

BAGLET

Beginning at bottom with **A**, cast on 32 sts. Work in Seed st for 4 rows. Now add ruffles as follows:

Row 1 (Wrong Side): With B knit across working into every other space at top of ribbon – ruffle will form at back (right side) of work. Do NOT turn.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): Slide work to opposite end of needle and purl across with **A**; TURN. Row 3 (Right Side): Pick up **B**, bringing it underneath A, and purl across – ruffle will form at front (right side) of work. Do NOT turn. Row 4 (Right Side): Slide work to opposite end of needle and purl across with **A**; TURN. Repeat Rows 1-4 until 6" (15 cm) from beginning or desired length for depth of bag, ending with Row 4.

Top Border

Continue with **A**, work 3 rows in Seed st. Bind off in pattern.

FINISHING

With right sides together, fold piece in half to form 4" x 6" (10 x 15 cm). Sew bottom seam and one side seam being careful not to sew ruffle into seam.

Strap

With crochet hook and **A**, ch 180; slip st in back loop of 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Turn baglet inside out and lay flat. Sew one end of strap to bottom corner and up the inside of the seam. Repeat for other side with opposite end of strap up the inside of the fold. Refer to diagram for strap placement. Weave in any loose ends. Turn baglet right side out.

Drawstring Closure (Optional)

With crochet hook and **A**, ch 75. Fasten off. Weave drawstring through top border of baglet one row below bind-off edge.




Abbreviations

A, B = color A, B; ch = chain; K = knit; mm = millimeters; P = purl; St st = Stockinette stitch (Knit on right side rows; Purl on wrong side rows.); st(s) = stitch (es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
