

NECK WARMER CAPELET | KNIT





Neck Warmer Capelet

Designed by Ann Regis

Directions are for size Small. Changes for sizes Medium and Large are in parentheses.

RED HEART® "Collage™": 3 (4, 4) skeins 2350 Blue Wave.

Knitting Needles: 8mm [US 11] 24" long circular. Stitch markers. Yarn needle.

Six buttons, 1/2" diameter.

GAUGE: 12 sts = 4"; 17 rows = 4" in Stockinette Stitch holding 2 strands of yarn together. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE**. Use any size needles to obtain the specified gauge.

Finished Circumference at Lower Edge: 54 (57, 61)". Finished Length: $19\frac{1}{2} (20, 20\frac{1}{2})$ ".

Seed st (odd number of sts)

Row 1: *K1, p1; repeat from* across to last st, k1. **Row 2:** Knit the purl sts and purl the knit sts.

Repeat Row 2 for Seed st.

NOTES: Hold 2 strands of yarn together throughout. Capelet is worked from the neck down to lower edge back and forth in rows. Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of stitches.

CAPELET

Holding 2 strands of yarn together, cast on 41 (45, 49) sts. **Row 1 (WS):** P5, place marker for Left Front, p6 (7, 8) for Shoulder, place marker, p19 (21, 23) for Back, place marker, p6 (7, 8) for Shoulder, place marker, p5 for Right Front.

Row 2: K1-f/b, [slip 1 wyib, p1] twice, k1, M1, k4 (5, 6), M1, k6 (7, 8), [p1, slip 1 wyib] 4 times, p1, k6 (7, 8), M1, k4 (5, 6), M1, k1, [p1, slip 1 wyib] twice, K1-f/b.

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: K1-f/b, [p1, slip 1 wyib] twice, p1, k1, M1, k6 (7, 8), M1, k6 (7, 8), [p1, slip 1 wyib] 4 times, p1, k6 (7, 8), M1, k6 (7, 8), M1, k1, [p1, slip 1 wyib] twice, p1, K1-f/b.

Row 5: Purl.

Row 6: K1-f/b, [slip 1 wyib, p1] 3 times, k1, M1, k to 1 st before next marker, M1, k6 (7, 8), [p1, slip 1 wyib] 4 times, p1, k6 (7, 8), M1, k to 1 st before next marker, M1, k1, [p1, slip 1 wyib] 3 times, K1-f/b.

Row 7: Purl.

Row 8: K1-f/b, [p1, slip 1 wyib] 3 times, p1, k1, M1, k to 1 st before next marker, M1, k6 (7, 8), [p1, slip 1 wyib] 4 times, p1, k6 (7, 8), M1, k to 1 st before next marker, M1, k1, [p1, slip 1 wyib] 3 times, p1, K1-f/b.

Row 9: Purl.

Row 10: Cast on 5 (5, 7) sts, [k1, p1] 2 (2, 3) times, k1, [p1, slip 1 wyib] 4 times, p1, k1, M1, k to 1 st before next marker, M1, k6 (7, 8), [p1, slip 1 wyib] 4 times, p1, k6 (7, 8), M1, k to 1 st before next marker, M1, k1, [p1, slip 1 wyib] 4 times, p1.

Row 11: Cast on 5 (5, 7) sts, [k1, p1] 2 (2, 3) times, k1, purl to last 5 (5, 7) sts, [k1, p1] 2 (2, 3) times, k1.

Row 12: Work in Seed st as established on 5 (5, 7) sts,

[k1, p1] 2 (2, 3) times, k1, [p1, slip 1 wyib] 4 times, p1, k1, M1, k to 1 st before next marker, M1, k6 (7, 8), [p1, slip 1 wyib] 4 times, p1, k6 (7, 8), M1, k to 1 st before next marker, M1, k1, [p1, slip 1 wyib] 4 times, p1, work in Seed st as established on last 5 (5, 7) sts.

Buttonhole Row: Work in Seed st on 2 (2, 3) sts, yo, work 2 st together, work in Seed st on 1 (1, 2) sts, purl to last 5 (5, 7) sts, work in Seed st on last 5 (5, 7) sts.

Row 14: Repeat Row 12.

Row 15: Keeping first and last 5 (5, 7) sts in Seed st as established, purl across center sts.

Repeat last 2 rows 19 (20, 21) more times, repeating Buttonhole Row every 6th row 3 more times, until there are 58 (61, 64) between Shoulder stitch markers – 163 (171, 183) sts.

Work in Seed st for 5 rows. Bind off in Seed st.

FINISHING

With right side facing, pick up and knit 5 (5, 7) sts over Seed st Front border, pick up and knit 55 (59, 63) evenly spaced around neck, pick and knit 5 (5, 7) sts over Seed st Front border -65 (69, 77) sts.

Row 1 (WS): Work in Seed st on 5 (5, 7) sts, *work in K1, p1 rib to last 6 (6, 8) sts, k1, work in Seed st on last 5 (5, 7) sts.

Keeping first and last 5 (5, 7) sts in Seed st and center sts in K1, p1 rib as established, work until piece measures 6", working 2 more Buttonholes evenly spaced. Bind off.

Sew buttons opposite buttonholes. Weave in ends.



RED HEART® "Collage™", Art.E748 (3.5 ounce/218 yard ball).

ABBREVIATIONS: K = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarn over; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.

Special Abbreviations:

K1-f/b= Knit into front and back of st.

M1= Make 1.

Slip 1 wyib= Slip 1 st with yarn in back.
