





KNIT SKILL LEVEL **EASY**

What you will need:

RED HEART® Treasure™: 3 balls 1913 Spectrum

Susan Bates® Circular Knitting Needle: 6.5 mm [US 10.5], 29" [40 cm] long

Stitch marker

GAUGE: 15 sts = 4" [10 cm]: 22 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Ridge stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Sophisticated Shoulder Cozy

Depending on your day, the weather or your mood, this cowl can also be worn as a hood up over your head or as a shoulder cozy down over your shoulders. The beautifully shaded yarn is thick-and-thin and adds interesting texture.

Directions are for size Small, Changes for sizes Medium, Large, X-Large are in parentheses.

Finished Measurement around bottom edge: 44 (48, 52, 56)" [112 (122, 132, 142) cm1

Finished Measurement around neck edge: 34 (38, 42, 46)" [86.5 (96.5, 106.5,

117) cm] Finished Length: 13" [33 cm]

NOTE

Cowl is worked in the round on circular needle, beginning at the bottom edge and worked up to neck edge.

PATTERN STITCH Ridge Stitch

Rounds 1-5: Knit. Round 6: Purl.

Repeat Rounds 1-6 for Ridge st.

COWI

Cast on 165 (180, 195, 210) sts. Join to work in rounds, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of round.

Purl 1 round, Knit 1 round, Purl 1 round,

Beginning with Round 1, work in Ridge st until piece measures 12½" [31.5 cm] from beginning, end with Round 4. Decrease Round: K6 (14, 3, 10), [k2tog, k2 (2, 3, 3)] 38 times, end K7 (14, 2, 10) -118 (132, 146, 160) sts remain.

Purl 1 round. Knit 1 round. Purl 1 round.

Bind off knitwise.



FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm = centimeters; k = knit; k2tog = knit 2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es); tog = together; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
