



Shoulder Cozy for Mom

Choose two favorite shades for this wonderful cowl and knit the perfect shoulder warming cozy. It's a season-spanning style that is easy-care and comfortable to wear.

Designed by Renee' Barnes, adapted by Scarlet Taylor.

Directions are for size Small/Medium; changes for sizes Large/XLarge and XXLarge/XXXLarge are in parentheses.

Circumference at lower edge: 42½ (47, 51)".
Length: 13½".

Red Heart® With Love™: 1 skein each 1623 Mallard A and 1601 Lettuce B.

Circular Knitting Needles: 6mm [US 10].
12 (13, 14) Stitch markers, yarn needle.

GAUGE: 15 sts = 4"; 21 rounds = 4" in St st. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

Note

For additional length, repeat stripe(s) before beginning cozy shaping.

K2, p2 Rib (worked over a multiple of 4 sts)

Round 1 (Right Side): * K2, p2; repeat from * around. Repeat Round 1 for K2, p2 rib.

Stripe Sequence

1 round with B, 7 rounds with A, 2 rounds with B, 6 rounds with A, 3 rounds with B, 5 rounds with A, 4 rounds with B, 4 rounds with A, 5 rounds with B, 3 rounds with A, 1 round with B **, 5 rounds with B, 2 rounds with A, 7 rounds with B, 1 round with A, 1 round with B.

COWL

With A, cast on 160 (176, 192) sts. Place marker for beginning of round and join, being careful not to twist sts. Work 8 rounds in K2, p2 rib.

Begin Stripe Sequence

Work in St st (knit every round) and Stripe Sequence to **.

Shape Cowl

Next Round: Continue in Stripe Sequence, * k14, k2tog, place a marker; repeat from * around—150 (165, 180) sts. Work 2 rounds even.

Next Round: * Knit to 2 sts before marker, k2tog; repeat from * around.

Repeat last 3 rounds 4 times more and last round of Stripe Sequence has been completed—100 (110, 120) sts.

Neck Band

With B, work 8 rounds in K2, p2 rib. Bind off in pattern.

FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends.



Red Heart® With Love™, Art. E400 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 390 yd (357 m); multi-color 5 oz (141 g), 230 yd (211 m) skeins.

Abbreviations: K = knit; mm = millimeters, p = purl; st(s) = stitch(es); St st = Stockinette stitch; tog = together; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
