





KNIT SKILL LEVEL **EASY**

What you will need:

RED HEART® Evermore™: 8 (9, 10, 11, 12) balls 9938 Keepsake

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 9mm [US 13] Yarn needle

GAUGE: 11 sts = 4" (10 cm); 14 rows = 4" (10 cm) inpattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.



Evermore™. SUPER BULKY Art E858 available in 3.5 oz (100 g), 87 yd (81 m) balls



Easy Boat Neck Poncho

This poncho is easy to wear with jeans and can be dressed up too! Evermore is such a cozy yarn, the bulky weight means it works up quickly and keeps you warm!

Directions are for size Small. Changes for sizes Medium, Large, X-Large, and XX-Large are in parentheses.

To fit bust: 32-34 (36-38, 40-42, 44-46, 48-50)" [81.5-86.5 (91.5-96.5, 101.5-

106.5, 112-117, 122-127) cm)]

Finished Width: 40 (42, 44, 46, 48)" [101.5 (106.5, 112, 117, 122) cm]

Finished Length: 20 (21½, 22, 23½, 24½)"

[51 (54.5, 56, 59.5, 62) cm]

Notes: Each poncho panel is worked from side to side, then sewn together. To accommodate the fabric width, you may prefer working back and forth in rows on a circular needle.

PONCHO

Panel (make 2)

Cast on 58 (62, 66, 70, 74) sts.

Row 1: Knit across.

Row 2 (right side): K2, yo, k2tog, *k2, k into the back of next st, p1; repeat from *

to last 6 sts, k2, k2tog, yo, k2.

Row 3 (wrong side): K2, p2, *k2, k into the back of next st, p1; repeat from * to

last 6 sts, k2, p2, k2.

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures 39½ (41½, 43½, 45½, 47½)" [100.5 (105.5, 110.5, 115.5, 120.5) cm] from cast on edge, ending with Row 2.

Next row (wrong side): Knit across. Bind off as if to knit.

FINISHING

With yarn needle and wrong sides of panels together, sew shoulder seams across one long edge as follows: Begin first shoulder seam at a top corner and sew for about 15 (16, 16½, 17½, 18)" [38 (40.5, 42, 44.5, 45.5) cm]. Repeat on opposite shoulder seam, leaving center 10 (10, 11, 11, 12)" [25.5 (25.5, 28, 28, 30.5) cm] open for neck. With yarn needle, tack lower corners together to form sleeve. Weave in all loose ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit: **k2tog** = knit the next 2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; st(s) = stitch(es); yo = yarn over; * = rep whatever follows the * as indicated



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
