Scarf measures $54\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " without fringe.

Stitch Nation by Debbie Stoller™ "Full o' Sheep™": 2 Balls 2260 Clementine.

Knitting Needles: 5.5mm [US 9].

Cable needle, crochet hook (for fringe), yarn needle.

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4''; 22 rows = 4'' in St st. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Cable: Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold to front, K3, K3 from cable needle.

SCARE

Cast on 34 sts. K 8 rows.

Begin Cable Pattern

Row 1 (Wrong Side): K8, P6, K6, P6, K8.

Row 2 (Right Side): K4, P4, cable over next 6 sts, P6, cable over

next 6 sts, P4, K4. Row 3: Repeat Row 1.

Row 4: K4, P4, K6, P6, K6, P4, K4.

Rows 5-6: Repeat Rows 3-4.

Repeat Rows 1-6 until scarf measures 53" from beginning. K 8 rows. Bind off loosely. Weave in ends.

FINISHING

Seven fringe knots are evenly spaced along each end of scarf as follows. Cut a piece of cardboard the length desired for fringe plus ½" trimming allowance. Wind yarn loosely around cardboard 56 times. Cut yarn across one edge.

For each fringe, use four lengths of yarn folded in half. Hold scarf with right side facing you. Use crochet hook to draw folded end through scarf from right to wrong side; pull fringe ends through folded section and draw knot up neatly. Trim ends evenly.

ABBREVIATIONS: K = knit; mm = millimeters; St st = Stockinette stitch (Knit on right side rows; Purl on wrong side rows.); st(s) = stitch (es).



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
