





KNIT SKILL LEVEL **EASY**

What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft™: 2 balls 9273 Very Pink

Susan Bates® Circular Knitting Needles: 5mm [US 8] 16" [41 cm] long

Stitch marker, yarn needle

GAUGE: 17 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 23 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette Stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART* Soft*, Art. E728 available in solid color 5 oz (141 g), 256 yd (234 m), print 4 oz (113 g), 204 yd (187 m), and heather 4 oz (113 g), 212 yd (194 m) balls



Stunning Knit Cowl

When days are cold and dreary, lift your spirits with a knit cowl in a color that will make you happy! Sections of Stockinette Stitch alternate with Seed Stitch sections with edges finished in a simple rib.

Cowl Measures 20" length x 26" circumference [51 cm x 66 cm]

NOTE

Cowl is worked in the round.

COWI

Using the long-tail cast on method, cast on 110 stitches. Place stitch marker for beginning of round. Join being careful not to twist stitches.

Rounds 1-6: Work in K1, P1 Ribbing.

Stockinette Stitch Section Work in Stockinette Stitch (knit every Round) for 4" [10 cm].

Seed Stitch Section

Round 1: *K1, P1; repeat from * around. Round 2: *P1, K1; repeat from * around.

Repeat Rounds 1-2 of Seed Stitch Section for a total of 3" [7.5 cm].

Change to Stockinette Stitch and work for 4" [10 cm].

Change to Seed Stitch and work for 3" [7.5 cm].

Change to Stockinette Stitch and work for 4" [10 cm].

Rounds 1-6: Work in K1, P1 Ribbing. Bind off all stitches in Ribbing.

FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in all ends. Block lightly.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm = centimeters; K = knit; mm = millimeters; **P** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es; St st = Stockinette stitch; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
