What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Gleam™: 5 balls 3251 Canyon/Copper

Susan Bates[®] Circular Knitting Needles: 5 mm [US 8] 36" long

Stitch marker, yarn needle

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 16 rounds = 4" [10 cm] in Garter Stripe Cross Stitch pattern.
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

Garter and Lace Cowl

Yarn this interesting deserves a stitch pattern that is just as interesting—and the Garter Stripe Cross Stitch fills the bill perfectly! Choose from beautiful fashion shades with either gold, silver or copper metallic threads wrapping in an irregular pattern.

Cowl Measures: 20" high x 70" circumference [51 cm x 178 cm]

GARTER STRIPE CROSS STITCH PATTERN

(multiple of 8 sts)

Round 1: *Knit next stitch, wrapping yarn around needle 3 times; repeat from * around.

Round 2: *Slip 8 sts from LH needle to RH needle, dropping wraps; using LH needle, pass first 4 sts over last 4 sts; slip these 8 sts, in this order, back to LH needle and knit, forming cross; repeat from * around.

Round 3: Purl.

Round 4: Knit.

Rounds 5-6: Repeat Rounds 3-4.

Round 7: Purl.

Round 8: Remove beginning of Round marker and slip first 4 sts to RH needle. Replace marker and repeat Round 1.

Round 9: Repeat Round 2. After Round 9 is completed, remove beginning of Round marker again, slip last 4 sts of Round 9 back to LH needle; replace marker.

Rounds 10-14: Repeat Rounds 3-7. Repeat Rounds 1-14 for pattern.

COWL

Loosely cast on 280 sts. Join, being careful not to twist stitches. Place stitch marker to mark beginning of round.


Round 1: Knit.

Round 2: Purl.

Rounds 3-4: Repeat Rounds 1-2. Begin Garter Stripe Cross Stitch pattern working Rounds 1-14, 6 times, then work

Rounds 1-6 once.

Last Round: Loosely bind off all sts purlwise.



FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in ends.

cm = centimeters; K = knit; LH = Left Hand;
 mm = millimeters; P = purl; RH = Right
 Hand; st(s) = stitch(es).
