What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique
Treasure™: 3 balls 1923 Tapestry

Susan Bates® Circular Knitting
Needle: 6mm [US 10] 29" [74 cm] long

Cable needle, stitch marker, yarn needle
Five 7/8" [22 mm] LaMode, style 31111, wood buttons

GAUGE: 22 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in K2, p2 rib. 20 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Cable st. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

SHOP KIT

Ups-and-Down Cowl

Knit cables are combined with shaded wool blend yarn for a cowl you'll love wearing! Beautifully designed with ribbed edges and buttonhole closure, it's the perfect cold weather accessory.

Cowl measures 12" long x 30" circumference [30.5 cm x 76 cm].

NOTE

Cowl is worked back and forth in rows. Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of stitches.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

3/3 LC: Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k3, then k3 from cable needle.

3/3 RC: Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k3, then k3 from cable needle.

kfb: Knit 1 front and back (increase) Knit next st, then knit it through back loop.

PATTERN STITCHES

K2, p2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts + 2)

Row 1 (Right Side): [K2, p2] to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2: [P2, k2] to last 2 sts, p2.

Repeat Rows 1-2 for K2, p2 rib.

Cable Stitch

Row 1 (Wrong Side): Purl.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: *3/3 RC, k6; repeat from * to end of row.

Rows 5-7: Repeat Rows 1-3.

Row 8: *K6, 3/3 LC; repeat from * to end of row.

Repeat Rows 1-8 for Cable st

COWL

Cast on 166 sts.

Row 1-2: Work in K2, p2 rib.

Buttonhole Row 3 (Right Side): K2, bind off 2 sts, work in pattern to end of row.

Row 4: Work in pattern to last 6 sts, p2, cast on 2 sts, p2.

Rows 5-6: Work in K2, p2 rib.

Row 7: K2, p2, k1, kfb, work in K2, p2 rib to last 6 sts, kfb, k1, p2, k2 – 168 sts.

Row 8 (Wrong Side): P2, k2, p2, beginning with Row 1, work in Cable st to last 6 sts, p2, k2, p2.

*Keep first and last 6 sts in K2, p2 rib and remaining sts in Cable st, work until piece measures 2½" [6.5 cm], end with a wrong side row. Repeat Buttonhole Row, casting on 2 sts over bind-off sts of Buttonhole Row on next row.

Repeat from * for 2 more times – 4 buttonholes made.

Work in pattern as established until piece measures 11" [28 cm] from beginning, end with a wrong side row.

Next Row (Right Side): K2, p2, k1, k2tog, work in K2, p2 rib to last 7 sts, k2tog, k1, p2, k2 – 166 sts.

Work 1 row in K2 p2 rib.

Buttonhole Row (Right Side): K2, bind off 2 sts, work in pattern to end of row.

Next Row: Work in pattern to last 6 sts, p2, cast on 2 sts, p2.

Work 3 rows in K2 p2 rib.

Bind off in rib.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Sew on buttons opposite buttonholes.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm = centimeters; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit 2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * **or** ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
