What you will need:

Red Heart® Boutique Sashay Fringe[™]: 1 ball 1968 Indigo

Knitting Needles: 5.5mm [US9]

Sewing needle and matching sewing thread

GAUGE: Gauge is not important for this project.



SUPER BULKY Fringe™, Art. E782F, available in solids 3.5 oz (100g), 13 yd (12 m) balls



Infinite Ruffles Cowl

This infinity loop cowl is a relaxed way to finish off a casual outfit with panache. The clever version of ruffling yarn has a fashionable fringe edging that is soft and comfortable to wear.

Cowl measures 52" (132 cm) in circumference

Notes:

- 1. Stretch one end of the Sashay open for several inches and lay it flat, placing the edge with the fringe along the bottom. Notice that the Sashay Fringe yarn is a mesh of holes. You will be working with the top of the mesh and leaving the fringe edge loose to form the ruffle. You are using the top railroad track of holes as if it is yarn.
- 2. If watching the attached video to learn to use Sashay, keep in mind that this pattern uses every hole rather than every-other-hole.

COWL

Beginning at the top right edge, insert tip of a knitting needle from back to front starting 4" (10 cm) from end and using top row of holes (railroad tracks). Continue inserting needle 4 more times. You now have 5 cast on stitches. Place this needle in left hand.

Pick up right hand needle and knit between the top two threads of the mesh (railroad tracks) going into every hole.

Continue knitting these 5 stitches on each row, turning your work in the same direction at end of rows.

Put your work down and open up the mesh as you go. Stop knitting when you have 20" (50.1 cm) left for binding off.

FINISHING

Bind off as usual drawing the end of the Sashay Fringe through the last bound off stitch. Trim leaving a 4" (10 cm) end. To finish the ends, fold under the corner and tack to inside with sewing needle and thread. Sew the two ends together to form a cowl.
