What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Chic™:
2 balls 1901 Pimento

Susan Bates® Circular Knitting
Needle: 10mm [US 15], 24"
(60 cm) long

Stitch marker, yarn needle

GAUGE: 8 stitches = 4" (10 cm); 12 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Stockinette stitch worked in rounds (knit every round). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

Have a Ball Cowl

No one will believe that this is easy enough for a beginner to knit! Puffs of fur add fun and texture to this snuggly cowl.

Cowl measures 24" (61 cm) circumference and 10" (25.5 cm) long.

Notes

1. Cowl is worked in rounds on a circular needle. A stitch marker is used to indicate the beginning of the round. Slip the marker when you come to it.
2. Gently guide the bobbles within the yarn to the right side as you knit.

COWL

Cast on 48 stitches. Place marker for beginning of round. Join to work in the round, taking care not to twist the stitches.

Round 1 (right side): Purl.

Rounds 2–6: Knit.

Rounds 7–30: Repeat Rounds 1–6 four more times.

Round 31: Purl.

Bind off loosely as if to knit.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
