



## Infinite Beauty Cowl

*Enjoy having color changes happen magically as you knit with this ingenious yarn that is a combination of shiny, brushed, metallic and multicolored fibers. You'll be amazed at how easy it is to make this stunning cowl!*

Designed by Cathy Payson.

**Cowl measures: 9" x 60".**

**RED HEART® Boutique™ “Magical™”:** 2 balls 1901 Open Sesame.

**Circular Knitting Needles:** 6mm [US 10] 36".  
Stitch marker, yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 13 sts = 4"; 22 rows = 4" in Zig Zag Eyelet Trellis pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge given.**

### Special Abbreviation

**Ssk** = Slip next 2 sts knitwise, one at a time to right needle; insert point of left needle into the fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together from this position.

### Zig Zag Eyelet Trellis (worked over an even number of sts)

**Rounds 1, 3 and 5:** K1, \* yo, k2tog; repeat from \* to last st, k1.

**Rounds 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 and 12:** Knit.

**Rounds 7, 9 and 11:** K1, \* ssk, yo; repeat from \* around to last st, k1.

Repeat Rounds 1 – 12 for pattern.

### COWL

Cast on 200 sts.

Place marker for beginning of round and join, being careful not to twist sts. Purl 1 round even.

### Begin Pattern

**Next Round:** Begin with Round 1, work in Zig Zag Eyelet Trellis pattern until piece measures 9".

Purl 1 round even. Bind off purlwise.

### FINISHING

Sew or slip st last row to first row to form a ring. Weave in ends.
