



## Charming Cowl

*Simply knit this easy cowl as a flat piece and then sew up the back seam. An attractive alternative to the usual scarf, it will keep you warm whether wearing a coat or working inside with the thermostat set low.*

Designed by Mareva Lynde.

**One size fits most.**

**Circumference at lower edge:** 36".

**Circumference at neck:** 27".

**Length:** 9½".

**RED HEART® “Soft Yarn”:** 1 ball 9440 Lt Grey Heather.

**Knitting Needles:** 5.5mm [US 9].  
Yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 15 sts = 4" in Seed st. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**  
**Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

### NOTE

Row gauge is not critical for this project.  
Cowl is worked in one piece from the top down.

**Seed Stitch (worked over an even number of sts).**

**Row 1 (Right Side):** \* K1, p1; repeat from \* across.

**Row 2:** \* P1, k1; repeat from \* across.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for Seed st.

### Yarn Over Pattern

**Row 1:** K2 \* yo, k2tog; repeat from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Repeat Row 1 for Yarn over pattern.

### COWL

Cast on 110 sts.

Work in Seed st for 3", end by working a wrong side row.

Knit 3 rows Garter st.

Work in Yarn over pattern for 6".

Knit 2 rows Garter st. Bind off knitwise.

### FINISHING

Sew back seam. Weave in yarn ends.



**RED HEART® “Soft Yarn”, Art. E728**  
available in solid color 5 oz (140 g),  
256 yd (234 m), print 4 oz (113 g), 204 yd  
(187 m), and heathers 4oz, (113g) 212 yd  
(194m) balls.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** **K** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl;  
**st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together; **yo** = yarn over; **\* or \*\*** =  
repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
