



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

Pat = Pattern

PM = Place marker

PssO = Pass slipped stitch over

RS = Right side

Sl1 = Slip next stitch knitwise

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

Yo = Yarn over

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® O'Go™ (Prints: 5 oz/141 g; 236 yds/215 m)
Newsprint (7124) **1 O'Go**



Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Yarn needle.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 20" [51 cm] circumference
x 11" [28 cm] high.

GAUGE

16 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in
Lace Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove
- Start knitting!
- Cowl is worked flat and then seamed to form tube.

Cast on 81 sts.

1st row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

Rep 1st row 9 times more.

Next row: *K1. yo. K3. Sl1. K2tog. pssso. K3. yo. Rep from * to last st. K1.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures 9½" [24 cm] from beg, ending on a 2nd row.

Rep 1st row 10 times more.

Cast off. Cut yarn leaving 24" [61 cm] tail. Sew sides tog, forming Cowl.
