strolling Mitts

Whether strolling to your city office or driving to your local grocery, these knit mitts are sure to put you in a brighter frame of mind while getting to your destination. Enjoy trying this beautiful lace pattern on a small accessory that won't take forever to knit.

One size fits most.
Wristers measure: 8" circumference.

STITCH NATION by Debbie Stoller™ "Washable Ewe™":
1 ball 3903 Strawberry.

Double Pointed Knitting Needles: 4mm [US 6].
Stitch markers (5), stitch holder, yarn needle.

GAUGE: 22 sts = 4"; 32 rounds = 4" in St st. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

M1-r (make 1 right slanting st) = Insert left needle into running thread before next stitch from back to front. Knit into the front loop of strand.

M1-l (make one left slanting st) = Insert left needle into running thread before next stitch from front to back. Knit into the back loop of strand.

Ssk = Slip next 2 sts knitwise, one at a time to right needle; insert point of left needle into the fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together from this position.

Lace Pattern (worked over 17 sts)

Round 1: K2tog, yo, k3, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3, yo, ssk.

Round 2 and all even rounds: Knit even.

Round 3: K1, k2tog, yo, k3, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k3, yo, ssk, k1.

Round 5: K2, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, yo, ssk, k2.

Round 7: K3, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, yo, ssk, k3.

Round 9: K4, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, yo, ssk, k4.

Round 11: K5, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k5.

Round 13: K6, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k6.

Round 14: Knit.

Repeat Rounds 1 – 14 for Lace pattern.

MITTS

RIGHT HAND

Cast on 40 sts and divide evenly among 3 double pointed needles. Place a marker and join, being careful not to twist sts.

Round 1: Purl even around.

Round 2: Knit even around.

Set up Lace Pattern

Next Round: K1, place marker, work Row 1 of Lace pattern over next 17 sts, place marker, k22.

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Continue in St st, working sts between markers in Lace pattern until piece measures 3", end by working an even numbered round of Lace pattern.

Shape Gusset

Next Round: K1, work 17 sts of Lace pattern, k1, place marker, m1-r, k1, m1-l, place marker, k20–42 sts.

Knit 1 round even.

Next Round: K1, work 17 sts of Lace pattern, k1, slip marker, m1-r, k3, m1-l, slip marker, k20–44 sts.

Continue working in this manner, increasing between gusset markers every other round until there are 15 gusset sts, end by working an even numbered round of Lace pattern.

Next Round: K1, work 17 sts of Lace Pattern, k1, place next 15 sts onto st holder, cast on 1 st, k20–40 sts

Work in pattern as established until piece is 7¼". Purl 1 round. Bind off knitwise.

Thumb

Divide 15 gusset sts evenly among 3 double pointed needles. Knit even until thumb measures 1". Purl 1 round. Bind off knitwise.

LEFT HAND

Cast on 40 sts and divide evenly among 3 double pointed needles. Place a marker and join, being careful not to twist sts.

Round 1: Purl even around.

Round 2: Knit even around.

Setup Lace Pattern

Next Round: K22, place marker, work Row 1 of Lace pattern over next 17 sts, place marker, k1.

Continue in St st, working sts between markers in Lace pattern until piece measures 3", end by working an even numbered round of Lace pattern.

Shape Gusset

Next Round: K20, place marker, m1-r, k1, m1-l, place marker, k1, work 17 sts of Lace pattern, k1.

Knit 1 round even.

Next Round: K20, slip marker, m1-r, k3, m1-l, slip marker, k1, work 17 sts of Lace pattern, k1.

Continue working in this manner, increasing between gusset markers every other round until there are 15 gusset sts, end by working an even numbered round of Lace pattern.

Next Round: K20, place next 15 sts onto st holder, cast on 1 st, k1, work 17 sts of Lace pattern, k1–40 sts

Work in pattern as established until piece measures 7¼". Purl 1 round. Bind off knitwise.

Thumb

Work same as for Right Hand.

FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: K = knit; mm = millimeters; p = purl; st(s) = stitch(es); St st = Stockinette st (k every round); tog = together; yo = yarn over; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
