

## Heavenly Lace Knit Wristers

Put a little sparkle in your knitting with this subtly metallic sock weight yarn. These wristers are perfect warmers from morning to night, always keeping your fingers free to type, knit or get a coin out of your wallet.

Designed by Lorna Miser.
Each wrister measures $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ long and 8 " around hand.
RED HEART® Stardust ${ }^{\text {™ }}$ : 1 ball 1701 Pink.

Double Pointed Knitting Needles: One set of four 2.75 mm [US 2]

Yarn needle, stitch holder, 2 stitch markers.
GAUGE: 24 sts $=4$ "; 36 rounds $=4$ " in rib patterns. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

## Special Stitches

M1 = Make 1 (Increase) - Lift strand between needles to left-hand needle and knit strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole.
ssk = slip next two stitches knitwise to right needle, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together through back loop.

## Pattern Stitches

$2 \times 3$ Rib (multiple of 5 sts; worked in rounds)
Round 1: *P1, k3, p1; repeat from * around.
Repeat Round 1 for $2 \times 3$ Rib.
Lace Rib (multiple of 5 sts, worked in rounds)
Round 1: *P1, k2tog, yo, k1, p1; repeat from * around.
Round 2: *P1, k3, p1; repeat from * around.
Round 3: *P1, k1, yo, ssk, p1; repeat from * around.
Round 4: *P1, k3, p1; repeat from * around.
Repeat Rounds 1-4 for Lace Rib.

## RIGHT WRISTER

Cast on 50 sts. Place marker for beginning of round. Work in rounds.
Beginning with a purl round, work in Garter st worked in rounds (purl 1 round, knit 1 round) for 4 rounds.

## Begin Rib Pattern

Next Round: Beginning with Round 1 of patterns, work Lace Rib over first 25 sts, place marker (to separate patterns), work $2 \times 3$ Rib over last 25 sts.
Continue in patterns as established, working Lace Rib over first 25 sts and $2 \times 3$ Rib over last 25 sts of each round and slipping markers as you come to them, until piece measures $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from beginning.

## Shape Thumb Gusset

Round 1: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, M1, place marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round- 51 sts. Round 2: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, p1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round.
Round 3: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, M1, k1, M1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round- 53 sts.
Round 4: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker,
$\mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 1$, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round. Round 5: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, M1, k3, M1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round-55 sts.
Round 6: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, p1, k3, p1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round.
Round 7: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, M1, p1, k3, p1, M1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round-57 sts.
Round 8: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, p2, k3, p2, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round.
Round 9: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, M1, p2, k3, p2, M1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round-59 sts.
Round 10: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, k1, p2, k3, p2, k1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round.
Round 11: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, M1, k1, p2, k3, p2, k1, M1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round-61 sts.
Round 12: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, k2, p2, k3, p2, k2, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round.
Round 13: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, M1, k2, p2, k3, p2, k2, M1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round-63 sts.
Round 14: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, [k3, p2] 2 times, k3, slip marker, work in $2 x 3$ Rib to end of round.
Round 15: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, M1, [k3, p2] 2 times, k3, M1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round-65 sts.
Round 16: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, p1, [k3, p2] 2 times, k3, p1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round.
Round 17: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, M1, p1, [k3, p2] 2 times, k3, p1, M1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round- 67 sts.
Round 18: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, p2, [k3, p2] 3 times, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round.
Round 19: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, M1, p2, [k3, p2] 3 times, M1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round-69 sts.
Round 20: Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, slip marker, k1, p2, [k3, p2] 3 times, k1, slip marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round.
Round 21 (divide thumb and hand): Continue in Lace Rib to first marker, remove marker, slip next 19 sts onto holder for thumb, remove next marker, work in $2 \times 3$ Rib to end of round-50 sts remain on needle for hand.
Round 22: Continue in Lace Rib over first 25 sts, work $2 \times 3$ Rib over last 25 sts.

Repeat last round until piece measures 8 " from beginning. Beginning with a purl round, work in Garter st worked in rounds for 4 rounds. Bind off.

## Thumb

Return 19 thumb sts to needle, pick up and k1 st from edge of hand-20 sts for thumb.
Work in $2 \times 3$ Rib as established for 10 rounds.
Bind off.

## LEFT WRISTER

Cast on 50 sts. Place marker for beginning of round. Work in rounds.
Beginning with a purl round, work in Garter st worked in rounds for 4 rounds.

## Begin Rib Pattern

Next Round: Beginning with Round 1 of patterns, work $2 x 3$ Rib over first 25 sts, place marker (to separate patterns), work Lace Rib over last 25 sts.
Continue in patterns as established, working $2 \times 3$ Rib over first 25 sts and Lace Rib over last 25 sts of each round and slipping markers as you come to them, until piece measures $31 / 2$ " from beginning.
Complete left wrister in same manner as right wrister, working $2 x 3$ Rib over the first 25 sts and Lace Rib over the last 25 sts.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

RED HEART® Stardust ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Art. E783
available in tweed with metallic 1.76 oz $(50 \mathrm{~g}), 191 \mathrm{yd}(175 \mathrm{~m})$ balls.

ABBREVIATIONS: $\mathbf{k}=$ knit; $\mathbf{p}=$ purl; $\mathbf{s t}(\mathbf{s})=$ stitch(es); yo = yarn over; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
