



City Gauntlets

When you knit with this yarn, it's like knitting with four yarns in one. The transitions in the yarn appear magically as you knit along. These long wristers are a fun knit project that are great to wear or to give to special recipients!

Designed by Jane Prater.

Directions are for size Small/Medium; changes for size Large/XLarge are in parentheses.

Wristers measure 10 (11½)'' at widest part x 16'' long.

RED HEART® Boutique™ Magical™: 1 (2) ball(s) 1351 Abracadabra.

Double Pointed Knitting Needles: 4mm [US 6].
Stitch markers (2), yarn needle.

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4''; 24 Rounds = 4'' in St st. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.**

Special Abbreviation

M1 (make one stitch) = Lift running thread before next stitch onto left needle and knit into the back loop.

WRISTER (Make 2)

Cast on 30 (36) sts and divide evenly among 3 double pointed needles. Place a marker and join, being careful not to twist sts.

Work 14 rounds in Garter st (k1 round, p1 round).

Divide for Thumb Opening

Turn and work opening back and forth in rows.

Row 1: Knit to end. Turn, and continue working back and forth in rows in Garter Ridge pattern as follows:

Rows 2 – 5: Knit.

Row 6 (wrong side): Purl.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: Purl.

Rows 9 – 13: Knit.

Join to complete in the round.

Work in St st (knit every round) for 2''.

Shape Wrist

Rounds 1 – 4: * K1, p1; repeat from * around.

Cuff

Round 1: K1, m1, knit to end of round.

Rounds 2 - 6: Knit.

Repeat Rounds 1 – 6 until piece measures 14'' from beginning.

Shape Cuff

Round 1: * K1, p1; repeat from * around.

Repeat last round until piece measures 16'' from beginning. Bind off.

FINISHING

Thumb

Pick up and k20 sts evenly around edge of thumb opening.

Round 1: Knit.

Round 2: * K1, p1 around.

Repeat Round 2 until thumb measures ¾''.

Next Round: Knit.

Next Round: Purl.

Repeat last 2 rounds once more.

Bind off. Weave in yarn ends.
